Newsbrief

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus asked the Department of Social Services to urgently reform outdated systems and enhance digital transparency. The Chief Adviser also asked the department to prioritize services for senior citizens and women in a bid to ensure benefits reach those who truly need those. The Chief Adviser said this in a meeting with senior officials of the Department of Social Services at the State Guest House Jamuna in Dhaka yesterday.

Asserting that the July rekindled the people's hope for a just, equal and corruption-free country, Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus called upon all to come forward towards building a Bangladesh together where tyranny will never rise again. The Chief Adviser made the call in a message issued yesterday on the occasion of the July Uprising Day. The sacrifice of thousands has gifted them this rare opportunity for national reform and all must protect it at any cost, the Adviser added.

Finance Adviser Dr Salehuddin Ahmed said that Bangladesh's economy has made a turnaround, with foreign currency reserves strengthening and traders regaining confidence. The Adviser said this while speaking as the chief guest at a discussion marking the 'July Uprising Day' at the Central Bank Headquarters in the capital yesterday.

Finance Adviser Dr Salehuddin Ahmed called upon the critics to also highlight the positive aspects of the economy since they often tend to criticize the interim government's economic measures despite progress in various indicators. The Adviser was addressing at a seminar as the chief guest on activities of income tax, VAT and Customs in the national budget for fiscal year 2025-26 and also the inauguration of the e-return submission for the 2025-26 year at the NBR in Dhaka yesterday. The seminar was organized to brief journalists on the changes made in income tax, VAT and customs policies in the budget for the fiscal year 2025-26.

Foreign Affairs Adviser Md. Touhid Hossain said that Bangladesh has not yet received any positive response from India regarding its formal request to extradite ousted former Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina to face trial in the country. The Adviser told reporters at the Foreign Service Academy in Dhaka yesterday. The Adviser also said, the government is awaiting a response from New Delhi and reaffirmed that legal proceedings against the former Premier have already commenced in her absence.

Home Adviser Lieutenant General Md. Jahangir Alam Chowdhury (Retd.) said, there are no security threats ahead of the events marking the July Mass Uprising Day today. The government is on high alert, the Adviser told reporters following a meeting on law and order at the Home Ministry in the Bangladesh Secretariat yesterday.

Education Adviser Dr CR Abrar said, those sacrifice of July fighters would not go in vein as a nation. The Adviser also said, it is not forgettable what was heard and seen in the documentary displayed in here. The Adviser made this remark in a rally and celebration of July 24 on the occasion of Madrasha resistance day of July Uprising. Vocational and Madrasha Education division organized the event at capital's Golapbag ground yesterday.

Land Adviser Ali Imam Majumdar said, if the acquired land is not used properly, the land must be returned to the District Administrator. The Adviser told this at the first meeting of the Advisory Council Committee on 'Utilization and Restoration of Acquired, Unused and Occupied Land' chaired by the Land Adviser at the conference room of his Ministry yesterday.

Palestine Ambassador Yousef S Y Ramadan paid a courtesy call on Education Adviser Professor Dr Chowdhury Rafiqul Abrar at latter's office in Secretariat yesterday. During the meeting, the Adviser expressed agreement with the envoy on advancing the education systems of both Bangladesh and Palestine through mutual cooperation.

Industries Adviser Adilur Rahman Khan said that the interim government has been prioritizing sustainable and green tourism by taking various initiatives to strike a balance between economic growth, environmental protection and cultural conservation. The Adviser made the remarks while inaugurating a four-day international workshop titled 'Workshop on Sustainable Practices in Green Tourism' at a hotel in Dhaka yesterday.

Environment, Forest and Climate Change Adviser Syeda Rizwana Hasan sought support from Islamic scholars in addressing noise pollution. The Adviser said this while speaking at a consultation held at the Department of Environment yesterday.

Information and Broadcasting Adviser Md. Mahfuj Alam said that they are liable to the dreams and sacrifices of July mass uprising martyrs and injured. The Adviser also said, multi-dimensional initiatives have been taken at the government level to publish books and make films focusing on the July mass uprising. The Adviser said this while inaugurating ceremony of the Publication Festival 2025, organized by the Department of Films and Publications at Tathya Bhaban in Dhaka yesterday.

Fisheries and Livestock Adviser Farida Akhter said that dictatorship and fascist regimes can no longer survive in Bangladesh. The Adviser said this while inaugurating the 'Mughda Mancha' at Rabindra Sarobar in Uttara Sector 3 yesterday, built in memory of Mir Mahfuzur Rahman Mughda, a martyr of the July Uprising. Dhaka North City Corporation built the 'Mughda Mancha'.

Primary and Mass Education Adviser Professor Dr Bidhan Ranjan Roy Poddar said, the government is working to ensure equitable and quality education for primary school students in the country. The Adviser said this while addressing the 'Government Primary School Feeding Programme Roll-out Session' workshop held at the Begum Rokeya Auditorium of Rangpur RDRS Bhaban in Rangpur yesterday.

The July Declaration will be presented before the nation today. The declaration will be unveiled at a public gathering at South Plaza of Jatiya Sangsad Bhaban, Chief Adviser's Deputy Press Secretary Abul Kalam Azad Majumder said yesterday.

Two more deaths were reported from dengue and 395 more patients were hospitalized with viral fever in the 24 hours till Monday morning, according to the Directorate General of Health Services yesterday.
