Newsbrief

The holy Eid-ul-Fitr, one of the biggest religious festivals of Muslims, is being celebrated in Bangladesh today as the moon of Shawwal month of 1446 Hijri was sighted in the country's sky last evening. Religious Affairs Adviser AFM Khalid Hossain told reporters after a meeting of the National Moon Sighting Committee, held at the Islamic Foundation at Baitul Mukarram National Mosque in Dhaka yesterday.

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus greeted the countrymen on the occasion of Eid-ul-Fitr. The Chief Adviser said this in a video message shared by his press wing yesterday. He also urged the people of the country to visit the graves of their relatives, check on poor families and think about how to improve their future.

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus expressed his greetings to the resilient and courageous July Konnya (July Girls/Women) for receiving a prestigious US award. The Chief Adviser said this in a statement issued by his press wing yesterday.

Chief of Army Staff General Waker-uz-Zaman paid a courtesy call on Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus at the State Guest House Jamuna in Dhaka. The Chief Adviser was apprised by the Army Chief of the overall security measures centering the Eid-ul-Fitr, according to a press release of the Directorate of Inter-Services Public Relations yesterday.

Home Affairs Adviser Lt Gen Md. Jahangir Alam Chowdhury (ret'd) said, the law enforcement agencies are ready to tackle any situation on the occasion of the Eid-ul-Fitr.
