Newsbrief

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus directed the authorities concerned to conduct a probe into the incident of New Age editor Nurul Kabir's harassment at Hazrat Shahjalal International Airport in Dhaka, according to a statement issued by Chief Adviser's Press Wing yesterday.

The World Bank launched an exhibition, showcasing an inspiring collection of wall arts created by students and youths from across the country, reflecting their hopes and aspirations for a prosperous and inclusive Bangladesh. Finance Adviser Dr. Salehuddin Ahmed inaugurated the exhibition, titled "Paint Your Sky, Make it Yours: Future Bangladesh in the eyes of the youth" at DrikPath Bhaban, Panthapath in the capital yesterday.

Southeast University yesterday organized a discussion and cultural event commemorating the university's four students embraced martyrdom during the student-led mass uprising. Land Adviser AF Hassan Ariff was present on the occasion titled "Building Tomorrow's Bangladesh with the Spirit of Sacrifices".

The Foreign Affairs Adviser underlined the need for a national consensus to address the Rohingya crisis, which has been further complicated by the ongoing civil war in Myanmar, particularly in Rakhine State. The Adviser said this while addressing a national dialogue on Rohingya policy organized by the South Asian Institute of Policy and Governance of North South University at the Bangladesh Institute of International and Strategic Studies in Dhaka yesterday.

Information and Broadcasting Adviser Md. Nahid Islam said, the government should work to reach the fruits of the July mass uprising at every doorstep. The Adviser said this while addressing the closing ceremony of 11th GSC National Scientist Mania held at Government Science College in Dhaka yesterday. Urging all to remain alert, he said ill efforts are going on to make the students controversial. Disputes and conflicts among the students are presenting them in a negative way before the countrymen, the Adviser added.

Adviser for the Ministry of Commerce Sk Bashir Uddin said, work is going on to build a dignified society where the rôle of the journalists is very important. The Adviser said this while distributing cheques of stipends among the children of the deceased members of Dhaka Reporters Unity (DRU) at the DRU Auditorium in the capital yesterday.

Chittagong Hill Tracts Affairs Adviser Supradip Chakma said, the government wants to work together by strengthening harmony, peace and amity among people of all communities in the country. The Adviser made this remark while addressing the traditional Nabanna Festival -2024, celebrated during the harvest season in November and December, of Garo Community at Banani Model School and College grounds in the capital on Friday, according to a Ministry's press release yesterday.

Primary and Mass Education Adviser Professor Dr. Bidhan Ranjan Roy Podder said, more entrepreneurs are needed for the development of the country. The Adviser said this while speaking at the closing ceremony of 'Global Entrepreneurship Week 2024', organised by Department of Innovation and Entrepreneurship of Daffodil University in the capital yesterday.

Bangladesh's newly appointed Ambassador to Italy ATM Rokebul Haque stressed the need of more effective role of FAO for uninterrupted exports of agriculture goods during global emergencies and disasters sidestepping export restrictions by any country. The Ambassador made this remark while presenting his credentials to FAO Director-General QU Dongyu as the Permanent Representative of Bangladesh at FAO Headquarters in Rome yesterday.

BNP's Acting Chairman Tarique Rahman said, the people's mandate through election could make the ongoing reforms sustainable. The BNP Acting Chairman said this while addressing the council of Chuadanga district BNP virtually from London yesterday.

The newly appointed Inspector General of Police (IGP) Dr. Baharul Alam asked police officers concerned to investigate the cases filed after August 5 properly so that no innocent individual was harassed. The IGP gave the directives to the field level senior police officers while presiding over a meeting on the overall law and order and security of the country at the Police Headquarters yesterday.
