Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus appreciated Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Pakistan Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif for agreeing to a ceasefire. The Chief Adviser wrote this in a message yesterday. The Chief Adviser also expressed his deep appreciation to US President Donald Trump and Secretary of State Rubio for their effective mediation.

Buddha Purnima, the most sacred and largest religious festival of the Buddhists will be celebrated today across the country with traditional enthusiasm and due religious fervour. On the occasion of Buddha Purnima, Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus in a message, greeted the members of the Buddhist community and the countrymen. In a message on the festival, the Chief Adviser said, Bangladesh is a country of communal harmony as people of all faiths, irrespective of race, religion and caste, have been living together in this country for thousands of years. The Chief Adviser added that this country is a safe abode for all people, regardless of religion, creed and caste.

Buddhist religious leaders and the leaders of the Buddhist religious welfare trust met the Chief Adviser on the occasion of Buddha Purnima. During the meeting, they exchanged greetings with the Chief Adviser at the state guest house Jamuna yesterday.

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus yesterday expressed deep shock at the death of renowned musician, researcher and writer Mustafa Zaman Abbasi. In a condolence message the Chief Adviser said, the contribution of Mustafa Zaman Abbasi to the Bangladesh's music will be remembered forever. The Chief Adviser prayed for the eternal peace of the departed soul of Abbasi and conveyed deep sympathy to the bereaved family.

Comptroller and Auditor General (CAG) of Bangladesh Md. Nurul Islam submitted 46 compliance audit reports to Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus. The CAG handed over the compliance audit reports of various Ministries and Departments to the Chief Adviser at the state guest house Jamuna in Dhaka yesterday.

Home Adviser Lieutenant General (Retd) Md. Jahangir Alam Chowdhury reiterated that the people whose negligence in performing duties helped former President Md. Abdul Hamid leave the country would be punished. The Adviser was replying to multiple questions from journalists after completing the inspection of the immigration process at Hazrat Shahjalal International Airport, Dhaka.

Law Adviser Dr Asif Nazrul said, a notification banning all activities of Bangladesh Awami League will be issued on the next working day. The Adviser made the remarks while speaking at a press conference in front of the state guest house Jamuna in Dhaka yesterday after a meeting of the council of Advisers. The special meeting of the council of Advisers was held at Jamuna. Speaking about the outcomes of the meeting, Dr Asif Nazrul said, the council at its meeting approved the amendment to the International Crimes (Tribunals) Act. As per the amendment, he said, the International Crimes Tribunal will be able to punish any political party, its affiliated organisations or supporters' groups.

Ealiar, Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs Adviser Dr Asif Nazrul said, necessary measures are being taken to form Truth and Reconciliation Commission in the country. The Adviser revealed this while addressing as the chair at the meeting of views exchange on 'Disappearance Prevention and Remedies Ordinance, 2025' at the auditorium of Judicial Administration Training Institute in the capital yesterday.

Primary and Mass Education Adviser Bidhan Ranjan Roy Poddar said, the government is going to reintroduce the scholarship exam at primary level. The Adviser made the announcement while exchanging views on the improvement of primary education with the primary education officers and the government primary schools' headmasters in Lakshmipur yesterday.

Fisheries and Livestock Adviser Farida Akhter said, safe food must be ensured for all people. The Adviser said this while inaugurating the 7th International Scientific Conference on Food Safety and Health at Bangladesh Agriculture Research Council auditorium in Dhaka yesterday.
