Newsbrief

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus urged all citizens to immediately restore complete law and order in the country. In a statement, the Chief Adviser stressed ensuring that there would be no further attacks on properties associated with the family of Sheikh Hasina and politicians of the fascist Awami League party or against any citizen on any pretext. The anger of the activists who have attacked properties is understandable because they and their relatives and friends lived through years of tyranny under Hasina, the statement added.

Adviser to the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting Md. Nahid Islam yesterday reaffirmed the interim government's firm commitment to fulfilling people's aspirations despite facing multifaceted challenges including economic struggles and an ever-evolving political environment. The Adviser told BSS in an exclusive interview on completion of six months of the present government. The government's journey in the last six months has been through multi-dimensional experiences including encountering internal and external conspiracies, managing more than 100 movements, facing continuous political pressure along with economic hardship and broken state structure, the Adviser added.

The Judiciary Reform Commission (JRC) proposed decentralization of courts, recommending establishing permanent benches of the High Court in every Divisional Headquarters by amending the article 100 of the constitution. The proposal was made in the summary of the report of Judiciary Reform Commission, which was handed over to Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus at the State Guest House Jamuna in Dhaka on February 5. JRC Members Headed by Justice Shah Abu Naeem Mominur Rahman submitted the report to the Chief Adviser.

Foreign Affairs Adviser Md. Touhid Hossain yesterday said, Bangladesh in the past six months earned the foreign nations faith that Bangladesh by and large is on the right track under the interim government of Professor Muhammad Yunus. The Adviser told BSS on the completion of the six months of the incumbent interim government.

Home Adviser retired Lieutenant General Md Jahangir Alam Chwodhury said, the interim government has launched a massive campaign to retrain the police force under a changed curriculum to make the main law enforcement agency a more humane force. The Adviser told BSS yesterday on completion of the six months of the incumbent interim government.

Power, Energy and Mineral Resources Adviser Dr. Muhammad Fouzul Kabir Khan said, the interim government attached priority to ensuring uninterrupted power supply alongside bringing the power sector out from subsidies and inefficiencies through establishing transparency and accountability. The Adviser told BSS on completion of the six months of the incumbent interim government.

Local Government, Rural Development and Cooperatives Adviser Asif Mahmud Shojib Bhuyain said, the current government will take steps soon to ban Awami League (AL) as a political party. The Adviser said this in an interview with BSS yesterday on completion of the six months of the incumbent interim government.

Environment, Forest and Climate Change Adviser Syeda Rizwana Hasan yesterday said that botanical gardens are not merely recreational spaces but also vital centres for nature conservation. The Adviser told the Annual Botanical Conference 2024 arranged by Jahangirnagar University. Joining the event virtually from her Dhaka residence, the Adviser highlighted the government's ongoing efforts to protect endangered forest areas, including hilly and coastal forests.

Fisheries and Livestock Advisor Farida Akhter said, the government will import livestock from abroad for breeding, not for meat consumption. The Advisor said this while addressing a small dairy farmers' rally organized by Sammilito Khamari Parishad at Haripur Govt. Primary School premises under Shailkupa upazila of Jhenaidha district on Thursday.

Cultural Affairs Adviser Mostofa Sarwar Farooki said, the interim government does not believe in any kind of mob justice and the law enforcement agencies are on alert to handle the situation. The Adviser said this during a visit at Amar Ekushey Book Fair 2025 at Bangla Academy premises flanked with Chinese Ambassador in Bangladesh Yao Wen. The Adviser also called upon people to be responsible and not to be engaged in any extrajudicial activities, saying, it's time to build the country.

Bangladesh Jamaat-e-Islami Amir Dr. Shafiqur Rahman said, Sheikh Hasina is hatching conspiracy to create unrest across the country by inciting people though she is on run. Jamaat Amir said this while speaking as the chief guest in a public meeting organized by party the party's Narayanganj city and district units at the Narayanganj Osmani Stadium at Fatullah yesterday.
