## Newsbrief

Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs Adviser Professor Dr Asif Nazrul said, the fallen fascist Awami League considered carrying out oppression against the people as a constitutional power. The Adviser said while addressing as a panelist at a book launching ceremony at Supreme Court Bar Association Auditorium yesterday. The book titled 'Revolutionary Constitutionalism: And Why It Was Essential to Declare the Fifteenth Amendment Unconstitutional' written by Senior Advocate of the Supreme Court Dr. Sharif Bhuiyan was launched on the occasion.

Home Adviser Lt. Ge. (retd) Md. Jahangir Alam Chowdhury has sounded a note of warning of taking tougher action against the land grabbers. The Home Adviser was speaking as the chief guest at a programme marking the inauguration of the first phase of the project to re-excavate the traditional Shubhadhya Canal in Keraniganj in Dhaka yesterday.

Adviser to the Ministries of industries and public works Adilur Rahman Khan said that the ideas and writings of young people hold the power to inspire meaningful change in society. The Adviser made this remark at the award giving ceremony of the essay competition titled 'July through Your Eyes' organized by the July Biplob Parishad held at the Teacher-Student Center Auditorium of Dhaka University the day before yesterday.

Social Welfare, Women and Children Affairs Adviser Sharmeen S Murshid said that the quick response team has been working across the country to prevent violence against women. The Adviser said this while speaking as the chief guest at a function organized by non-government organization 'Jago Nari Unnayan Sangstha' in capital's Gulshan area yesterday.

Adviser to the Ministry of Civil Aviation and Tourism Sheikh Bashir Uddin has been appointed as the Chairman of the Board of Directors of Biman Bangladesh Airlines Limited. In this regard, a gazette notification was issued by the Ministry of Civil Aviation and Tourism yesterday.

On the eighth anniversary of atrocities in Myanmar's Rakhine state, the Organization of Islamic Cooperation (OIC) has reaffirmed support for Rohingya Muslims, urging justice, accountability and protection of their rights while renewing its call for international solidarity and durable solutions. In a statement yesterday issued on the occasion, the OIC expressed solidarity with the Rohingyas, who continue to face persecution, statelessness and forced displacement.

On the concluding day of the three-day international stakeholders' dialogue on the Rohingya crisis, foreign diplomats, representatives from UN agencies and international organizations, as well as leaders from Bangladeshi political parties visited Rohingya camps in Ukhiya of Cox's Bazar yesterday. During the visit, the delegates closely observed the Rohingyas' living conditions, healthcare services, education, food distribution and other humanitarian assistance activities. Deputy Press Secretary to the Chief Adviser, Abul Kalam Azad Majumder told that participants were taken to the Rohingya camps to gain a close understanding of the ground realities.

The Bangladesh Consulate General in New York has sent letters to the local police, the Mayor's office and the US State Department's regional office requesting legal action against Awami League miscreants involved in Sunday's incident. The Mission said this in a statement yesterday.

Shushasoner Jonno Nagorik (Shujan) Secretary and National Consensus Commission member Dr Badiul Alam Majumder said, the success of the July National Charter depends on its implementation. He said these at a citizen dialogue titled 'Proposed July Charter and Citizen Thoughts' organized by Shujan at the CIRDAP auditorium in the capital yesterday.

A contingent of 180 Bangladeshi policemen yesterday left Dhaka to join the UN peacekeeping mission in Democratic Republic of Congo, the second largest African country. According to a police statement the contingent flew to the middle African country aboard a chartered plane while Superintendent of Police Jannat Afroz leads the group that comprises 70 female police personnel.

A five-member committee of Cabinet Division, formed to probe the stone looting, visited Bholaganj Sada Pathor tourist spot under Companiganj in Sylhet. The committee, led by Secretary (Coordination and Reforms) of Cabinet Division Zaheda Parveen visited the Sada Pathor area yesterday.

Sylhet Deputy Commissioner Md. Sarwar Alam said, about 26 lakh cubic feet of stones looted from Bholaganj Sada Pathor have been recovered so far. He revealed the information while talking to reporters after visiting Sada Pathor area yesterday. Earlier, a three-day deadline set by the Sylhet district administration.

In a significant move towards fostering international youth collaboration, Bangladesh has officially joined the Hope Network or the Global Network for Youth Competitiveness. This decision, made in response to an invitation from the Ministry of Youth Affairs of the Government of Bahrain, opens new avenues for youth empowerment, innovation and cross-border partnerships. The announcement was made in a press release by the Ministry of Youth and Sports yesterday.

Inspector General (IG) of Prisons Brigadier General Syed Md. Motaher Hossain said, more than 700 prisoners out of over 2200 who escaped during the July Uprising are still fugitive. The IG of Prisons said this while responding to a question from the journalists in a briefing at the Prison Directorate Headquarters in the capital's Bakshibazar area yesterday.


