Newsbrief

Law adviser Dr Asif Nazrul said, institutional reforms were required alongside legal ones to prevent enforced disappearance calling the crime worse than murder. The Adviser told the inaugural session of a day-long workshop on the issue at a hotel of Gulshan in the capital yesterday. The Commission of Inquiry on Enforced Disappearances organized the workshop with assistance of the Office of the High Commissioner for Human Rights of the United Nations.

Home Adviser Lieutenant General (Retd) Md. Jahangir Alam Chowdhury said that experts from four foreign countries-England, Australia, China and Turkey-have been invited to investigate into the devastating fire at the Cargo Village of Hazrat Shahjalal International Airport in Dhaka. The Adviser told journalists after inspecting the fire site at the airport in Dhaka yesterday.

Housing and Public Works Adviser Adilur Rahman Khan said, the interim government is pledged bound to implement state reform initiatives and transform Bangladesh into a 'New Bangladesh' in line with the July National Charter and the July Declaration. The Adviser told a seminar titled 'Gum Nikristo Fascibadi Shasoner Hatiyar' at the Sheikh Mujibur Rahman Hall Auditorium yesterday. The seminar was organised on the occasion of unveiling the cover of a book named 'Aynaghorer Sakkhi: Gum Jiboner Aat Bochor' is written by Barrister Mir Ahmed Bin Quashem Arman depicting the incident of his detained life. Dhaka University Central Student Union (DUCSU) and Procchod Prokashon jointly organised the event.

Environment, Forest and Climate Change Adviser Syeda Rizwana Hasan emphasized collective efforts to free the Shitalakkhya River from pollution and restore its natural beauty. The Adviser made the remarks while addressing a day-long meeting with river and environmental activists at Dhadhar Char in Kapasia in Gazipur yesterday. The event was held with the slogan 'Save the River, Save Life.' The festive gathering carried a strong message of awareness and unity, emphasizing that everyone must come forward now to save the Shitalakkhya River.

Information and Broadcasting Adviser Md. Mahfuz Alam said, even though state fascism has gone, fascism remains in the social sphere. If there is no opportunity for dialogue and connection between all the streams of Islam in the country, the state will move forward with great apprehension.' The Adviser said this while speaking at a national dialogue titled 'Shrine Culture: Violence, Crisis and Future Thinking' at the BM Bhaban in the capital yesterday.

Social Welfare and Women and Children Affairs Adviser Sharmeen S Murshid said, the Children Act 2013 requires amendments to protect children. The Adviser said this while addressing a workshop titled 'Children's Act 2013: Doubts, Confusion and Inconsistencies' organized by the Law Commission and UNICEF Bangladesh at a hotel in the capital yesterday.

Fisheries and Livestock Adviser Farida Akhter put emphasis on ensuring care and protection of animals in zoos, saying 'It is a moral responsibility of us'. The Adviser made the remarks while speaking at a view-exchange meeting at the Interpretation Centre of Bangladesh National Zoo in Mirpur yesterday, following her visit to the zoo.



Chief Justice Dr Syed Refaat Ahmed said, justice strengthens the state, while the absence of justice can make even the strongest nations crumble. Citing the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, the Chief Justice said that global awareness of injustice and abuse of power gave rise to a renewed moral consciousness that upholds human dignity and freedom. The Chief Justice said this while addressing a ceremony to mark the 72nd founding anniversary of the Department of Law at Rajshahi University at its Kazi Nazrul Islam auditorium yesterday.

Chief Adviser's Special Assistant to the ICT Ministry Faiz Ahmad Taiyeb said, the government is updating and amending the Post Office Act 1898 to align with modern needs. The Special Assistant confirmed the development through a post on his verified Facebook page yesterday.

The International Monetary Fund (IMF) has welcomed the increase in foreign exchange reserves by the Bangladesh Bank. Deputy Director of the IMF's Asia and Pacific Department, Thomas Helbling said this at a press briefing in Hong Kong the day before yesterday on Asia-Pacific economic developments.

International Crimes Tribunal (ICT) Chief Prosecutor Muhammad Tajul Islam called upon the journalists to present story of every martyr of the July 2024 mass Uprising before the nation. The Chief Prosecutor told an event marking the 21st founding anniversary of the Daily Naya Diganta, held at the Bangladesh Shilpakala Academy yesterday.

Election Commissioner Abdur Rahmanuel Masud said, the Election Commission has no other choice beyond holding a good election to reinstate the public trust in the electoral process. The Commissioner said this in an interview with the BSS at his office in Election Bhaban at Agargaon yesterday.

At Bangladesh's initiative, the recently adopted Geneva Consensus at UNCTAD16 included a crucial provision urging continued international support for graduating Least Developed Countries to ensure their smooth and sustainable transition beyond graduation, according to a press release issued by the Permanent Mission of Bangladesh in Geneva, received in Dhaka yesterday.

The government has given a nod to create 2258 more posts for the paramilitary force Border Guard Bangladesh. According to the notification issued by the Home Ministry yesterday, the posts will be created for three battalions and a hospital facility of the force.




