Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus received an honorary doctorate degree from Peking University (PKU) in China today. The PKU conferred the honorary doctorate on the Bangladesh Chief Adviser at a function held at the university conference hall in Beijing. Chief Adviser Professor Yunus also delivered a lecture on the occasion.

China and Bangladesh yesterday decided to elevate their relations to a new height after a historic bilateral meeting between President Xi Jinping and Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus. The meeting held at the Chinese capital's Great Hall of the People discussed issues of mutual interest, with President Xi Jinping reiterating China's full support for the Chief Adviser and the reform agenda of the Interim Government.

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus said, the interim government's task is to rebuild a new Bangladesh and the Bangladeshi people hope that they can learn from China's experience in developing their own country. The Chief Adviser said this in an interview with Xinhua, the official state news agency of China yesterday.

Bangladesh and China signed nine instruments during the Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus's ongoing China tour. An agreement was signed on Economic and Technical Cooperation between the two governments. Chief Adviser's Deputy Press Secretary Abul Kalam Azad Majumder told this to BSS yesterday.

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus yesterday sought a fifty-year master plan from China to manage the river and water system in Bangladesh, which is crisscrossed by hundreds of rivers. The Chief Adviser made the call when Li Guoying, Water Resources Minister of China, met him at a state guest house in Beijing on the third day of his four-day visit to the Asian country.

Religious Affairs Adviser Dr. AFM Khalid Hossain yesterday lauded the children for their participation in Quran competition abroad and brought awards for the country. The Adviser said these while speaking at the grand finale and award distribution ceremony of PHP Quraner Alo: Talent Search at a city hotel as the chief guest.
