### Newsbrief

Law Adviser Dr. Asif Nazrul said, political consensus is needed to implement the immediate reforms proposed by the six reform commissions before holding the next general elections. The Adviser told a press briefing at Foreign Service Academy in Dhaka yesterday. All stakeholders of July uprising would speed up process to announce the July Proclamation, the Adviser added.

Home Affairs Adviser Lt. Gen. Md. Jahangir Alam Chowdhury (Retd.) vowed to take stern action against those involved in the heinous attack on the student-people in Gazipur district. The Adviser said this after visiting the injured at the Dhaka Medical College and Hospital yesterday.

Environment, Forest and Climate Change Adviser Syeda Rizwana Hasan yesterday said the interim government is working sincerely to protect the environment and biodiversity highlighting the interim government's success in environmental protection in last six months. In an interview with BSS on completion of six month of the interim government, The Adviser said, more than 2,000 acres of forest land have been recovered which would be utilized for various public projects.

Meanwhile, Environment, Forest and Climate Change Adviser Syeda Rizwana Hasan said, the anti-discrimination student movement will not only promote social equality but also bring positive changes in environmental protection. The Adviser said this while exchanging views with the Citizens' Committee and student leaders at the Rangpur Circuit House in Rangpur yesterday.

Religious Affairs Adviser Dr. AFM Khalid Hossain said, Muslims must be united in light with the holy Quran and Sunnah for greater interest shunning all differences. The Adviser told a discussion on the importance of Sunnah in Muslim life on Kaichabari Road in Ashulia, according to a press release yesterday.

The government decided to start a countrywide crackdown of the joint forces "Operation Devil Hunt" from today to bring culprits to book and maintain law and order. The decision was taken on Friday in a joint meeting of the law enforcement agencies following Friday's terror attack on the student-people in Gazipur district, according to a press release of the Home Ministry yesterday.

Chief Adviser's Press Secretary Shafiqul Alam said, Awami League, which was ousted through massive popular uprising, is carrying out a smear campaign against Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus. The Chief Adviser's Press Secretary said this while addressing the launching ceremony of a compilation book titled "Droher Graffiti: Chobisher Gono Obhyutthan" authored by Bangladesh Sangbad Sangstha (BSS) Deputy Chief News Editor GM Rajib Hossain at the Jatiya Press Club in Dhaka yesterday.

United Nation (UN) Secretary-General António Guterres reiterated the UN's continued commitment to a durable solution to the Rohingya crisis and assured Bangladesh of ensuring funding for the issue. The UN Secretary-General made the commitment when High Representative of Bangladesh's Chief Adviser on Rohingya Issue and Priority Matters Dr. Khalilur Rahman met him on Friday to discuss the upcoming UN International Conference on Rohingya Muslims and other Minorities of Myanmar, according to a press release yesterday. The UN General Assembly decided to hold the Conference by consensus.

BNP Acting Chairman Tarique Rahman has taken the responsibility of educational expenses of Al-Amin Howlader who has been qualified for admission into top-ranked Dhaka Medical College. News reports on uncertainty study of Al-Amin Howlader, a resident of Baufal upazila of Patuakhali district, due to insolvency came into notice of Tarique Rahman, he decided to stand by him. BNP Health Affairs Secretary Dr. Md. Rafiqul Islam handed over all educational materials including books, notebooks, aprons and cash to Al-Amin on behalf of Tarique Rahman yesterday.

Bangladesh Nationalist Party (BNP) Senior Joint Secretary General Ruhul Kabir Rizvi Ahmed said, future of Bangladesh will be uncertain without holding proper trial of the genocide committed during the July mass uprising. The BNP Senior Joint Secretary General said this at an urgent press conference at the BNP central office in Nayapaltan yesterday. The BNP Senior Joint Secretary General also said, trial of this genocide is crucial to establish the rule of law and justice in the country.
