Newsbrief

Foreign Affairs Adviser Md. Touhid Hossain has called for strengthening collaboration between Bangladesh and Turkiye in trade, investment and defence, reaffirming Dhaka's commitment to deepen the historic friendship between the two nations. The Adviser made the remarks when a five-member Turkish Parliamentary delegation, led by Mehmet Akif Yilmaz, Chairperson of the Bangladesh-Turkiye Parliamentary Friendship Group, paid a courtesy call on him at the Foreign Ministry the day before yesterday, according to a press release yesterday.

Home Adviser Lieutenant General (Retd) Md. Jahangir Alam Chowdhury said, the government is trying its best to bring back the fugitive police officers abroad after the 2024 July Uprising. The Adviser said this responding to queries from journalists following the Core Committee meeting on law and order at the Home Ministry in Bangladesh Secretariat in Dhaka yesterday. The Adviser also called on the police to play an impartial role in ensuring that the upcoming 13th Parliamentary elections are conducted in a free, fair, credible and festive manner.

Environment, Forest and Climate Change Adviser Syeda Rizwana Hasan has called upon South Asian nations to rebuild trust, strengthen regional connectivity and pursue joint action as global disorder becomes the new reality. She stressed that the region must act collectively to confront shared crises such as air and plastic pollution, water insecurity and escalating climate disasters. The Adviser made the call while addressing the opening plenary titled 'Sustainable Development in the Emerging World Disorder' as guest of honour at the SDPI Annual Conference in Islamabad, Pakistan yesterday.

Fisheries and Livestock Affairs Adviser Farida Akhter said, Bangladesh's representation at the UN Conference of the Parties (COP) should not be limited only to the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change but expanded to include officials from other concerned Ministries. The Adviser was addressing a workshop titled 'Participation of Stakeholders in COP-30' at CIRDAP auditorium in the capital yesterday.

Information and Broadcasting Adviser Md. Mahfuj Alam called upon all anti-fascist forces to be united and cooperate the government to implement the reforms. The Adviser made the call while meeting the families of the July martyrs at the Ramganj Upazila Parishad auditorium in Lakshmipur.

Information and Broadcasting Adviser Md. Mahfuj Alam described the Rammala Library as a priceless repository of cultural heritage. The Adviser told reporters after visiting the library in Cumilla yesterday. He said Cumilla's traditional Rammala Library houses thousands of rare manuscripts, ancient books, newspapers and historical documents. Although the library has played a significant role in the history of Bengali literature, it has long been neglected, the Adviser added.

Urging all to remain cautious against misleading information and potential disorder centering the upcoming national election, Chittagong Hill Tracts Affairs Adviser Supradip Chakma mentioned that fair election is a fundamental cornerstone of democracy. The Adviser made the remarks while speaking at Kathin Chivar Dan festival at the Basabo Dharmarajik Buddhist Mahavihar in the capital yesterday.


Bangladesh has underscored prospects for greater Filipino investment in emerging sectors and reiterated its aspiration to become a Sectoral Dialogue Partner of ASEAN during the 3rd Bangladesh-Philippines Foreign Policy Consultations (FPC) held in Manila the day before yesterday, according to a Foreign Ministry's press release said yesterday.

British High Commissioner to Bangladesh Sarah Cooke reaffirmed the United Kingdom's commitment to supporting Bangladesh's economic transformation and aviation growth. The High Commissioner made the remarks while speaking at the event titled 'European Dialogue on Bangladesh Aviation Growth' held at the French Embassy in Dhaka yesterday, attended by Ambassador-designate of France Jean-Marc Séré-Charlet, German Ambassador Rüdiger Lotz, and EU Ambassador Michael Miller.

A seminar on human resources between Bangladesh and Japan was held in Tokyo the day before yesterday when 13 memorandums of understanding and agreements were signed between Bangladeshi manpower sending agencies and Japanese recruitment firms. Bangladesh Embassy in Tokyo arranged the seminar titled 'A highly promising source of skilled human resources for Bangladesh and Japan' at the TKP Hall, followed by a matching event. The programme was held in collaboration with the Japan International Training Cooperation Organization. Bangladesh Ambassador to Japan Md. Daud Ali in his speech assured full support for sending skilled Bangladeshi workers to Japan and establishing an effective system. He also called on all stakeholders to work together on a partnership basis to achieve this goal.


