
Shipping Adviser Brigadier General (retd) M Sakhawat Hussain inaugurated Nagarbari port on the bank of the Jamuna River at Bera upazila in Pabna yesterday. Addressing a function on the occasion the Adviser said, the newly launched Nagarbari Port will boost country's economy through goods handling, generating employment and increasing revenue. The Adviser also said, the port will be operated by a private organization, which will also arrange all necessary port management equipment.
