Newsbrief

Home Adviser Lieutenant General Md. Jahangir Alam Chowdhury (Retd.) said, they were trying their best to expose the culprits at the quickest possible time involved in robbing Taka one crore in the capital's Uttara area yesterday morning wearing uniform like the Rapid Action Battalion (RAB). The Adviser replied to a question after coming out of a meeting of the core committee on law and order at the Home Ministry's conference room in Bangladesh Secretariat yesterday.

Syeda Rizwana Hasan, Adviser to the Ministry of Water Resources, suggested immediate response by the Water Development Board if any river erosion occurs. The Advisor made the suggestion while exchanging Eid greetings with ministry officials and staff on the first working day after Eid-ul-Azha. The event took place at the ministry's meeting room at the Secretariat yesterday. The Adviser urged officials to expedite the ongoing activities of various departments and affiliated organizations, emphasizing the need for increased efficiency and coordination.

Environment, Forest and Climate Change Adviser Syeda Rizwana Hasan stressed promoting the use of eco-friendly bamboo furniture. The Advisor said, the pressure on timber resources is steadily increasing in the country. The Environment Adviser made the remarks while attending a post-Eid greetings ceremony at the conference room of the Ministry of Environment yesterday. During the event, she exchanged Eid greetings with ministry officials and called upon them to work with renewed commitment toward environmental protection.

The Adviser to the Ministry of Civil Aviation and Tourism Sk. Bashir Uddin called for renewed dedication and enthusiasm in the ministry's activities following the Eid holidays. The Advisor made the call during a post-Eid courtesy meeting with officials at the ministry's conference room yesterday. The Advisor emphasized the need to accelerate initiatives that were in progress before the vacation, particularly those concerning reforms in laws and regulations as well as activities related to travel agencies.

Fisheries and Livestock Adviser Farida Akhtar said, cattle raisers or firm operators made brisk businesses thanks to higher sales of their cows during the Eid-ul-Azha this year. No cattle were imported this year, a ministry statement quoted the adviser as saying while exchanging Eid greeting with her ministry officials and employees at her office yesterday. The Advisor said the ministry and particularly the livestock department extended the cattle raisers and farm owners their hands throughout the past year resulting in adequate production of sacrificial animals.

Chief Adviser's Press Secretary Shafiqul Alam said, the historic meeting between Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus and BNP acting Chairman Tarique Rahman is a "game-over" moment for the conspirators. About the achievement of the Chief Adviser's UK tour, the Press Secretary said, Professor Yunus received a prestigious award from King Charles and held a 30-minute one-on-one meeting with the British monarch. It is a recognition of the July uprising and epochal changes in Bangladesh since July last year, the Press Secretary claimed. The National Crime Agency (NCA) of the United Kingdom freezes 320 properties worth £170 million of a top Hasina aide, the Press Secretary said yesterday.


Bangladesh Bank (BB) Governor Dr. Ahsan H. Mansur said that the United Kingdom (UK) is providing full support to Bangladesh in recovering laundered money linked to individuals associated with the regime of ousted Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina. The Governor said Bangladesh had requested mutual legal assistance from several countries, including the UK. As part of the process, Bangladesh handed over information about the properties of launderers and looted money. Based on the information, the foreign authorities take action, the Governor added yesterday.

Chinese Acting Ambassador to Bangladesh Liu Yuyin held a meeting with BNP Secretary General Mirza Fakhru Islam Alamgir yesterday. The meeting was held at the BNP Chairperson's political office in the city's Gulshan area, according to a spokesperson of the party yesterday.

Bangladesh's foreign exchange reserves stood at \$26.15 billion. As per the International Monetary Fund (IMF) methodology under the Balance of Payments and International Investment Position Manual (BPM6), Bangladesh's foreign exchange reserves stood at \$20.86 billion, said a Bangladesh Bank press release issued yesterday.

The Health Department confirmed 26 new COVID-19 infections in the 24 hours between 8 am Saturday and 8 am Sunday. A total of 291 samples were tested during this period. One more person has died from the coronavirus in the past 24 hours, bringing the total death toll to 29,503 since the pandemic began.

One more death was reported from dengue in the 24 hours till yesterday morning, raising the number of fatalities from the mosquito-borne disease in Bangladesh to 30 this year. The death was reported in the Dhaka South City Corporation (DSCC), according to the Directorate General of Health Services (DGHS).
