Finance Adviser Dr Salehuddin Ahmed urged all to work together for overcoming all challenges of the country's economy. The Adviser said this while speaking at the national finals of the Bangladesh Economics Olympiad 2025, held at Dhaka Residential Model College in the capital yesterday.

Environment, Forest and Climate Change Adviser Syeda Rizwana Hasan said, the interim government is performing three hard responsibilities reforms, justice and elections. The Adviser told reporters after attending a function in the capital yesterday. The Adviser also said, Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus has given a timeframe for next election between December 2025 and June 2026.

Earlier, Water Resources Adviser Syeda Rizwana Hasan said that the work of reclaiming and depolluting the Turag River will start soon. The Adviser came up with the remarks while speaking at the 24th National Conference and Annual General Meeting of the Bangladesh Zoological Society at the Nawab Ali Chowdhury Senate Building of Dhaka University yesterday as the chief guest.

Religious Affairs Adviser Dr A F M Khalid Hossain rushed to the Phyathai Hospital in Thailand to see July martyr Mohammad Hasan yesterday. Bangladesh Ambassador to Thailand Faiyaz Murshid Kazi and Labour Councilor Fahad Parvez Basunia were present. Hasan died in Thailand on Thursday while under treatment at a hospital following a gunshot wound to the head during the July-August mass uprising in Chattogram.

Chattogram Hill Tracts (CHT) Affairs Adviser Supradip Chakma underscored the need for implementing development works in urban and remote areas of the hilly region.
