### Newsbrief

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus called upon physicians to dedicate themselves to ensuring healthcare services for all. The Chief Adviser made the call as the chief guest at the inaugural session of the two-day Civil Surgeon Conference-2025 at the Chief Adviser's Office in Dhaka yesterday. The Civil Surgeon conference is being held for the first time in Bangladesh. The Chief Adviser also said, through the inauguration of the Civil Surgeon Conference, the health sector of Bangladesh has started a new journey, expressing his hope that it will also help develop a new mindset.

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus called for an integrated economic strategy among Bangladesh, Nepal, Bhutan and the seven north eastern states of India, emphasising the potential of cross-border collaboration in hydropower, healthcare and road connectivity. The Chief Adviser made the call when the visiting Deputy Speaker of the House of Representatives of the Federal Parliament of Nepal, Indira Rana called on him at his office in Dhaka yesterday. During the meeting, the Chief Adviser stressed the urgency of fostering regional cooperation through shared infrastructure and energy initiatives.

The interim government yesterday formed a committee to restructure the Rapid Action Battalion (RAB) that draws personnel from three armed services alongside police, Home Affairs Adviser retired Lieutenant General Md. Jahangir Alam Chowdhury said. The Adviser told reporters emerging from a meeting of the Advisory Council on law and order at his ministry's conference room at the Bangladesh Secretariat. The Adviser also said, they have taken several decisions to check extortions, snatching and other criminal acts to ensure safe celebration of the upcoming Eid-ul-Azha across the country.

Adviser to the Ministry of Local Government, Rural Development and Cooperatives, Asif Mahmud Shojib Bhuyain said that fulfilling the aspirations of the people following the July Uprising remains a key priority for the interim government. The Adviser said this in a post on his verified Facebook page yesterday. The Adviser also described the move to outlaw the Awami League as another victory for the July people.

Road Communication and Railways Adviser Muhammad Fouzul Kabir Khan said, the government would take every measure to ensure peoples safe journey during the upcoming Eid ul Azha holidays. The Adviser told reporters emerging from a meeting with officials concerned and stakeholders at Bidyut Bhaban in the capital yesterday.

A delegation of Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) led by its Chief Ichiguchi Tomohide called on Food Adviser Ali Imam Majumder at his office at Bangladesh Secretariat yesterday. During the meeting, the delegation discussed food safety testing capacity development project, financed by the JICA and emphasized on the selection of the director of the project and its consultants.

Special Envoy to the Chief Adviser for International Affairs, Lutfey Siddiqi, yesterday held a high-level meeting with top western diplomats to review the past eight months progress on labour reforms and outline the government's road map ahead. Ambassadors and High Commissioners USA, UK, Canada, European Union and ILO attended the meeting held at Chief Adviser's Office (CAO) in Tejgaon.

Home Ministry yesterday issued a gazette notification banning all activities of the Awami League and its all front, associate and brotherly organizations. This order will be effective immediately, the gazette said. The gazette was signed by the Senior Home Secretary Nasimul Ghani. The gazette was also issued by order of the President.

The Election Commission (EC) yesterday suspended the registration of Bangladesh Awami League. EC Senior Secretary Akhtar Ahmed confirmed it to the reporters after a meeting of the EC. A gazette notification was also issued in this regard.

Director General (DG) of the Border Guard Bangladesh (BGB) Major General Mohammad Ashrafuzzaman Siddiqui said that Indian boarder force pushed 202 individuals inside Bangladesh this month. The BGB DG said this after emerging from an Advisory Council meeting on law and order at the Home Ministry's conference room at the Bangladesh Secretariat yesterday.

Members of the U.S based human rights organization Robert F. Kennedy (RFK) Human Rights yesterday highly appreciated the activities of the Commission of Inquiry on enforced disappearances. A high-level delegation of RFK, during a meeting with the Commission of Inquiry on enforced disappearances, called for investigating every incident of enforced disappearance, expediting the trial of the accused and necessary institutional reforms.

The country's remittance inflow rose 13.3 percent year-on-year, reaching \$922 million in the 11 seven days of May, according to the latest data from Bangladesh Bank yesterday. The country received \$814 million in remittances during the same period last year, the data added.

The benchmark index DSEX dropped by 2.0 points . The Shariah-based DSES index fell by 1.0 point, while the blue-chip index DS30 declined by 7.0 points yesterday.


