### Newsbrief

Foreign Affairs Adviser Md. Touhid Hossain reiterated that no border guard force has the right to shoot and kill individuals along the border, stressing that those responsible for such acts should be brought to justice under Indian law. The Adviser told reporters at the Foreign Service Academy in Dhaka yesterday. The Adviser also said, Bangladesh's unwavering stance against terrorism and violent extremism is prepared to cooperate closely with the Malaysian authorities following the recent arrests of Bangladeshi nationals in Malaysia.

Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs and Expatriates' Welfare and Overseas Employment Adviser Professor Dr Asif Nazrul said, the interim government will ensure globally acceptable trials of the July massacre. The Adviser said this at a discussion organized at the Independence Memorial Square of Begum Rokeya University, Rangpur to mark the first martyrdom anniversary of Abu Sayeed and 'July Martyrs' Day 2025' yesterday as the guest of honor. The foundation stones of Shaheed Abu Sayeed Gate and Museum and Shaheed Abu Sayeed Memorial Monument have been laid at Begum Rokeya University, Rangpur.

Adviser to the Ministry of Land Ali Imam Majumder said that the Ministry is ready to take over all the sub-registry offices in the country. The Adviser told this to reporters at his office in the Bangladesh Secretariat yesterday.

Fisheries and Livestock Adviser Farida Akhter said, she actively participated in the July 2024 mass uprising through a platform called 'Khuddho Nari Samaj' as she herself was injured while participating in various programmes until the final victory of the student masses achieved. The Adviser said this at her Ministry office yesterday.

Adviser to the Ministry of Water Resources and Environment, Forest and Climate Change Syeda Rizwana Hasan has said martyrs like Abu Sayeed are our daily inspiration. The Adviser said this at a discussion organized at the Independence Memorial Square of Begum Rokeya University, Rangpur to mark the first martyrdom anniversary of Abu Sayeed and the occasion of 'July Martyrs Day-2025' yesterday as guest of honor. Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs Adviser Professor Dr Asif Nazrul was also present at the program.

Liberation War Affairs Adviser Faruk E Azam said that the government is committed to rehabilitating the families of those injured and killed during the July uprising with the highest dignity. The Adviser made the remarks at an event marking the inauguration of street memory stamps at Bahaddarhat and Muradpur intersections in Chattogram yesterday.

Chittagong Hill Tracts Affairs Adviser Supradip Chakma said that the July Revolution has established equity, friendship and human rights for the people of Bangladesh. The Adviser made these remarks while speaking as the chief guest at a doa mahfil held at the Chittagong Hill Tracts Complex Auditorium in the capital yesterday organized under the supervision of the Ministry of Chittagong Hill Tracts Affairs.

Chief Adviser's Special Assistant on Ministry of Posts, Telecommunications and Information Technology Faiz Ahmad Taiyeb said that July warriors will be made self-employed through digital training. He made the remarks while speaking as the chief guest at a seminar titled 'Youth Power: Language Movement 1952 to Quota Reform Movement 2024', organized by the Information and Communication Technology Division at the BCC Auditorium in the ICT Tower on the occasion of 'July Martyrs Day' and 'July Mass Uprising Day' yesterday.

Chief Adviser's Press Wing said, key pro-Awami League (AL) figures circulated false narratives surrounding violent clashes erupted in Gopalganj by posting multiple old and unrelated images in social media platforms. The press wing said this in a statement at its verified Facebook page - CA Press Wing Facts yesterday.

National Consensus Commission Vice-Chairman Professor Ali Riaz said that as all political parties are in agreement on the existing constitutional provision regarding the caretaker government, they have collectively decided to pursue a referendum should any future amendments to the system become necessary. He made this remark while presenting a summary at a discussion with political parties at the Foreign Service Academy in the capital yesterday.

The Ministry of Information and Broadcasting has taken an initiative to collect the memoirs of one lakh people on July Uprising through the 'Notes on July' postcards. These postcards have already been sent to the district information offices, according to a press release yesterday.

The Election Commission (EC) removed the Awami League's poll symbol 'Boat' from its website. EC Secretariat System Manager Engineer Md. Rafiqul Haque told this to reporters yesterday.

Dhaka Metropolitan Police (DMP) claimed that scrap trader of the old city Lal Chand alias Sohag was brutally killed following a business feud. DMP Commissioner Sheikh Md. Sajjat Ali said this at a press briefing at the DMP Media Centre in Dhaka yesterday.

Two dengue patients died and 321 have been hospitalized across the country in the last 24 hours, according to a press release issued by the Directorate General of Health Services yesterday.
