Newsbrief

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus will soon visit Aynaghor, secret cells where the victims of enforced disappearance were detained. Local and foreign media will accompany the Chief Adviser during his visit to Aynaghor. The decision was taken at a meeting of the Council of Advisers yesterday, according to a press release issued by Chief Adviser's Press Wing.

The Council of Advisers gave final approval to the draft ordinance of International Crimes (Tribunals) (Amendment) in principle with necessary amendments and subject to vetting by the Legislative and Parliamentary Affairs Division. The draft of International Crimes (Tribunals) (Amendment) Ordinance, 2025 has been framed to amend the International Crimes (Tribunals) Act, 1973 to make it more time befitting. The approval was given at a meeting of the Council of Advisers at the Chief Adviser's Office with Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus in the chair, according to a media release of the Cabinet Division yesterday.

Bangladesh lodged a formal protest with India over ousted former Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina's activities during her stay in India, which Dhaka considers provocative. Foreign Affairs Adviser Md. Touhid Hossain told reporters at a briefing at the Foreign Ministry yesterday. There was no reason to maintain strained relations with Pakistan, as he disclosed that Pakistan's Deputy Prime Minister and Foreign Minister Ishaq Dar is expected to visit Dhaka in April, the Foreign Adviser added.

Environment, Forest, and Climate Change Adviser Syeda Rizwana Hasan said, the interim government is focusing on three core priorities: justice, reforms and elections. The Adviser said this while speaking as the Chief Guest at Nordic Day Celebration at Radisson Blu hotel in Dhaka yesterday. The Adviser outlined the government's commitment to addressing past injustices, implementing necessary reforms and restoring democratic processes.

The government announced the names of 14 eminent citizens and Bangladesh Women's National Football Team for awarding the prestigious Ekushey Padak-2025, the country's second-highest civilian award, for their contribution to various fields. Cultural Affairs Adviser Mostofa Sarwar Farooki disclosed the names of the recipients at a press conference at the Bangladesh Secretariat yesterday.

The interim government has warned that it will deal with all anarchic acts with an iron hand. In a statement today, the government mentioned that it is deeply concerned that some individuals and quarters are trying to vandalise and set fire to various institutions and establishments across the country. The government is ready to protect the lives and properties of citizens, said the statement issued by the Chief Adviser's Press Wing.

The Anti-Corruption Commission (ACC) decided to investigate whether there was any 'wastage of money' behind deposed Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina's foreign trips and doctorate degrees from universities abroad. ACC Director General (Prevention) Md. Akhter Hossain gave this information to journalists at the ACC Head office yesterday.

BNP standing committee member Major (Retd) Hafiz Uddin Ahmed, Bir Bikram, said, deposed Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina is conspiring from Indian to create chaos in Bangladesh. Major (Retd) Hafiz told a discussion on 'The future of democracy in the current political context' at Jatiya Press Club in Dhaka yesterday.

Dhaka Metropolitan Police (DMP) Commissioner Sheikh Md. Sajjat Ali said, the traffic sergeants deployed on the roads and highways will get small arms to tackle snatching. The DMP Commissioner said this while talking to the journalists after inaugurating city bus service through counter and e-ticketing at Uttara Azompur Kanchabazar in Dhaka yesterday.

The prime index of the Dhaka Stock Exchange (DSE) increased 9.11 point to settle at 5,179.18 points yesterday.
