Newsbrief

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus said that if the nation becomes bewildered for any reason it will find path in the July Uprising Memorial Museum, noting it has been possible to build the museum while the blood of the July martyrs is still fresh. The Chief Adviser made the remarks yesterday after inspecting the progress of the final phase work of the July Uprising Memorial Museum at the Gonobhaban, the residence of ousted Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina. The Chief Adviser also said that every citizen of the country should come to the museum and spend a full day and that students should visit the museum in groups.

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus has emphasized that all looted weapons must be recovered as soon as possible ahead of the upcoming 13th national election to ensure law and order. The Chief Adviser made the remarks while presiding over the 119th meeting of the National Implementation Committee on Administrative Reorganization (NICAR) at the National Guest House Jamuna yesterday. This was the maiden NICAR meeting held during the tenure of the interim government.

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus has expressed profound shock and sorrow to Spanish President Pedro Sánchez Pérez-Castejón over the devastating accident of high-speed trains in Adamuz, near the city of Córdoba, Southern Spain on Sunday evening. The Chief Adviser wrote this in a condolence message to the Spanish President yesterday.

Finance Adviser Dr. Salehuddin Ahmed informed that the Pay Commission, formed to frame a new salary structure for the government employees, is scheduled to submit its report before the Chief Adviser today. The Adviser also said that the potential recommendations in the Pay Commission's report would first undergo scrutiny by relevant committees. The Adviser told this to journalists at Bangladesh Secretariat yesterday.

Youth and Sports Adviser Dr. Asif Nazrul said, Bangladesh cannot be compelled to play in the ICC Men's T20 World Cup in India by putting unreasonable pressure. The Adviser said this while speaking to journalists at Bangladesh Secretariat yesterday.

Food and Land Adviser Ali Imam Majumdar said, people are the owners of the country and none but they will choose 'managers' to run the state in the 13th parliamentary election, slated for February 12. The Adviser told a public awareness campaign on the referendum at Shaheed Hadis Park in Khulna yesterday. Another programme in Bagerhat district, The Adviser said, the referendum will be an important milestone for the upcoming governance of the country.

Information and Broadcasting Adviser Syeda Rizwana Hasan said, the forthcoming referendum is a matter of national interest and should not be viewed from partisan or personal perspectives. The Adviser made the remarks while delivering her speech at an event in Savar yesterday, which highlighted the issues related to the 2026 referendum and women and children. The program organized by Bangladesh Betar in collaboration with the Department of Mass Communication at Radio Colony ground in Savar under 'Awareness Campaign on Child, Adolescent and Women Development' project.

Shipping, Labour and Employment Adviser Brigadier General (R.) Dr. M Sakhawat Hussain said, casting a 'Yes' vote in the 2026 referendum is essential to bringing meaningful change in Bangladesh and advancing the country's democratic transformation. The Adviser made the remarks while addressing a views-exchange meeting on the Referendum 2026 campaign at the Panchagarh Government Auditorium in Panchagarh yesterday, organized by the district administration.

Liberation War Affairs and Disaster Management and Relief Adviser Faruk E Azam, Bir Pratik said, if the 'Yes' vote wins in the referendum, there will be radical changes in the state structure and a historic opportunity will be created to ensure the people's rights and freedom. The Adviser made the remarks while speaking at a courtyard meeting organized to motivate voters and increase public awareness on the occasion of the referendum and the 13th national elections. Arranged by the District Information Office, the meeting was held in Phapor Paschimpara under Bogura Sadar upazila yesterday.

Chittagong Hill Tracts (CHT) Affairs Adviser Supradip Chakma said that a fair and credible electoral environment cannot be ensured by CCTV cameras or technology alone rather it requires sincerity and purity of mind from all concerned. The Adviser also urged the people of the country to change their negative thinking and emphasized the importance of securing a 'Yes' victory in Referendum 2026 to keep the pace of development uninterrupted. The Adviser made these remarks the day before yesterday while attending at a views-exchange meeting on the 13th Jatiya Sangsad election and Referendum 2026 at the conference room of Magura Circuit House, said PID release yesterday.
