Finance Adviser Dr. Salehuddin Ahmed said that Bangladesh's economy has demonstrated resilience and gradual stabilization despite inheriting a challenging macroeconomic environment from the previous regime. The Finance Adviser was addressing the publication ceremony of the 7th edition of the 'Banking Almanac' at the CIRDAP International Conference Centre in the capital yesterday. The Adviser also called for collective efforts from policymakers, analysts and the media to present a balanced view of Bangladesh's achievements and challenges, stressing that with continued cooperation, the country can advance towards becoming a stronger and more respected economy.

LGRD and Cooperatives Adviser Adilur Rahman Khan assured that voters, along with their family members, will be able to cast their votes in a festive and fear-free environment in the upcoming 13th national elections, as the government has ensured a level playing field and a congenial atmosphere for all. The Adviser made the remarks while inaugurating the South Surma Kadamtali Central Bus Stand in Sylhet yesterday.

Information and Broadcasting Adviser Syeda Rizwana Hasan has urged concerned to avoid excessive lighting and the use of single-use plastics during international film festivals. The Adviser told the inauguration of the 24th Dhaka International Film Festival at the National Museum Auditorium at Shahbagh in the capital yesterday. The Adviser said, International film festivals strengthen cultural bonds, providing opportunities for individuals to understand each other through shared aspirations, values and knowledge exchange.



The Adviser also requested, if possible, to exempt B1 short term business visa for Bangladeshi businessmen from the visa bond, according to a press release of the Chief Adviser's Press Wing yesterday.

Newly appointed United States Ambassador to Bangladesh Brent Christensen was sworn-in at the US State Department in Washington on Friday, marking the beginning of his new diplomatic assignment, the US embassy said in Dhaka yesterday.
