Newsbrief

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus congratulated the Liberal Democratic Party of Japan on its historic and landslide victory in the election to the House of Representatives. The Chief Adviser said in a message sent to Japanese Prime Minister TAKAICHI Sanae yesterday. The Chief Adviser's Press Wing released the message yesterday.

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus described the recently signed Bangladesh–Japan Economic Partnership Agreement (EPA) as a historic and epoch-making deal for Bangladesh. The Chief Adviser made the remarks while presiding over a special meeting of the Council of Advisers at his Tejgaon office yesterday. Later, Chief Adviser's Press Secretary Shafiqul Alam briefed the media at the Foreign Service Academy to share the outcomes of the meeting.

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus said the country would undergo a fundamental transformation and misgovernance would not return if the "Yes" vote prevails in the referendum slated for February 12. The Chief Adviser told senior secretaries and secretaries at his office in Tejgaon yesterday. The Cabinet Secretary presided over the meeting. Chief Adviser's Press Secretary Shafiqul Alam briefed the media on the discussion at the Foreign Service Academy yesterday.

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus stressed upholding the Liberation War spirit, saying that the new generation needs inspiration from the country's Liberation War. Noting that this is not just one war, there will be more wars ahead. The Chief Adviser said that the spirit of our Liberation War should remain a source of inspiration from generation to generation. The Chief Adviser made the remarks at a meeting with leaders and members of the Jatio Muktijoddha Council (Jamuka), Bangladesh Freedom Fighter Welfare Trust (BFFWT) and Bangladesh Muktijoddha Shongshod (BMS) at the State Guest House Jamuna yesterday.

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus has expressed profound shock and sorrow at the death of Professor Dr Rita Süßmuth, Former Federal Minister for Women and Former President of the German Parliament. The Chief Adviser said in a condolence message sent to President of the German Bundestag Julia Klöckner on recently. The Chief Adviser's Press Wing released the message yesterday.

The Council of Advisers approved the drafts of the Bangladesh Public Service Commission Ordinance, 2026, the Bangladesh National Qualifications Framework Policy, 2026 and the National Fisheries Policy, 2026. The approvals were given at a special meeting of the Council of Advisers at the Chief Advisers' Office (CAO) in Tejgaon yesterday, with Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus in the chair.

Finance Adviser Dr Salehuddin Ahmed said that Bangladesh's economy is not in a bad shape right at this moment although it is facing formidable challenges that require sustained reforms, better coordination and strong political commitment from the next government. Speaking at a discussion meeting, the Adviser said that despite multiple domestic and global pressures, Bangladesh has managed to maintain macroeconomic stability and avoid a deep crisis. The Finance Adviser was addressing an event titled "Macroeconomic Insights: An Economic Reform Agenda for the Elected Government" as the chief guest held at a hotel in the capital yesterday.

Home Adviser Lieutenant General (Retd) Md. Jahangir Alam Chowdhury said that the Ministry of Religious Affairs will donate 13,000 religious books to the Department of Prisons. The announcement came during a courtesy call paid by Religious Affairs Adviser Dr. A F M Khalid Hossain to the Home Adviser at his office at the Home Ministry office at the Bangladesh Secretariat yesterday.

The Press Information Department (PID) has published a media guide to assist foreign media personnel arriving to cover the 2026 referendum and the 13th National Parliament election in carrying out their professional duties. The easy-to-carry book contains information on the Bangladesh Election Commission, government offices involved in election-related activities, key individuals, all returning officers, and phone numbers and email addresses of various agencies responsible for maintaining law and order during the election period, according to a PID handout issued yesterday.

The agreement on Reciprocal Tariff between Bangladesh and the United States was signed . On the Bangladesh side, the signatories were Commerce Adviser Sk Bashir Uddin and National Security Adviser Khalilur Rahman, and on US side Ambassador Jamieson Greer, US Trade Representative, said the Chief Adviser's Press Wing yesterday.
