Newsbrief

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus urged the countrymen to vote in the general elections to elect a new government and in the referendum to shape the future Bangladesh, saying it is a historic, decisive and future-defining moment for the nation. The Chief Adviser made the remarks while addressing the nation this evening on the occasion of the 13th Jatiya Sangsad (JS) election and the referendum on the implementation of the July National Charter on February 12.

The Japanese Election Observation Mission paid a courtesy call on Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus at the State Guest House Jamuna. The delegation was led by Masato Watanabe, Ambassador and Leader of the Japanese Election Observation Mission, said the Chief Adviser's Press Wing yesterday.

The EU Election Observer Mission (EU-EOM) paid a courtesy call on Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus at the State Guest House Jamuna yesterday. The delegation was led by Tom s Zdechovsky, Member of the European Parliament and Head of Delegation.

During the nationwide vote awareness campaign for the upcoming polls and the referendum, ordinary citizens from across the country have directly shared their thoughts, hopes, criticisms, and emotions with Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus through a unique initiative titled the "Public Opinion Box". Under the campaign for the 13th National Parliamentary Election and the Referendum 2026 with the slogan - "The Key to the Country is in Your Hands," the vote campaign vehicles traveled across the country, collecting handwritten messages addressed directly to the Chief Adviser, said the Chief Adviser's Press Wing yesterday.

An election observer team of the US-based International Republic Institute (IRI) met Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus at the State Guest House Jamuna. Former Congressman David Dreier led the five-member delegation, said the Chief Adviser's Press Wing yesterday. Finance Adviser Dr Salehuddin Ahmed said the interim government undertook several significant initiatives during its tenure, though many key reforms could not be fully completed due to structural and policy constraints. The Finance Adviser made the remarks while responding to reporters after chairing a meeting of the Advisers Council Committee on Government Purchase at the Cabinet Division conference room of the Bangladesh Secretariat yesterday.

Finance Adviser Dr Salehuddin Ahmed outlined some key economic challenges which the next government would face as the Adviser stressed on activating more trade and industry, generate more employments and strengthen financial sector institutions. The Adviser made the observations while responding various queries of reporters after chairing a meeting on the Advisers Council Committee on Government Purchase at the Cabinet Division conference room at Bangladesh Secretariat yesterday.

Education Adviser Professor Dr C R Abrar expressed his deep gratitude to the committee formed for policy reforms in the education sector and officials concerned who provided support in this regard. The Adviser said while addressing a dissemination seminar marking the submission of the final report of the Consultation Committee report at the ministry conference room yesterday.

Home Adviser said there is no apprehension about holding the upcoming 13th national election in a free, fair, peaceful and credible manner, as the highest number of law enforcement personnel in the country's history has been deployed. The Adviser said while responding to a question after attending a views exchange meeting with local administration officials, police, and other law enforcement agencies of district yesterday.

Disaster Management and Relief Adviser Faruk E Azam, Bir Protik, said that integrated capacity building for disaster management could be a key tool for achieving sustainable solutions. The Adviser made the remarks while delivering a speech as the chief guest at the handover ceremony of disaster-capacity equipment to the Armed Forces Division (AFD) under Phase 3 of the Project for Procurement of Equipment for Search, Rescue Operations and Emergency Communication during Earthquakes and Other Disasters yesterday.

Fisheries and Livestock Adviser Farida Akhter said the government has enacted and amended a number of acts, ordinances and regulations to protect the interests of marginal farmers while ensuring sustainable production, resource conservation and public health safety. The Adviser made the remarks at a press briefing at the conference room of the ministry, highlighting programmes undertaken and achievements during the tenure of the interim government yesterday.

Religious Adviser Dr AFM Khalid Hossain said pilgrims under Hajj Package-1 and 2 will get more than Taka three crore back after completing Hajj of 2026. Addressing a press briefing at the ministry conference room yesterday, the Adviser said, they have tried to work specifically on the desire of people to perform Hajj at a reasonable cost.

Commerce Adviser Sk. Bashir Uddin said that the signing of Agreement on Reciprocal Trade (ART) with the United States (US) is a pivotal milestone for bilateral relations. The Adviser said this while speaking at a press conference at the Ministry of Commerce conference room in the city, said a press release yesterday.
