Newsbrief

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus stressed upholding the Liberation War spirit, saying that the new generation needs inspiration from the country's Liberation War. None of us is permanent. But the inspiration of the Liberation War must endure for future generations so that they understand where the country came from and how the struggle for independence was carried out, the Chief Adviser said. The Chief Adviser made the remarks at a meeting with leaders and members of the Jatio Muktiyoddha Council (Jamuka), Bangladesh Freedom Fighter Welfare Trust (BFFWT) and Bangladesh Muktiyoddha Shongshod (BMS) at the State Guest House Jamuna yesterday.

Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus directed the authorities concerned to take effective measures to prevent forgery of skill development training certificates and the use of fake certificates to safeguard Bangladesh's reputation in the international labour market. The Chief Adviser made the remarks while presiding over a meeting of the Governing Body of the National Skills Development Authority (NSDA) at his office in the city's Tejgaon area, said the Chief Adviser's Press Wing yesterday.

Foreign Adviser Md. Touhid Hossain said the Muslim world must invest more in education, science and technology to transform its education systems and bring meaningful change to people's lives. The Adviser made the remarks while gracing the signing ceremony of a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between the Islamic University of Technology (IUT) and the SEACO Universities Network (SUN), held at the State Guest House Padma yesterday.

US Ambassador to Bangladesh Brent T Christensen met with Foreign Affairs Adviser Md Touhid Hossain and discussed issues of bilateral relations. Excellent meeting with the Advisor for Foreign Affairs Md. Touhid Hossain. We had a productive discussion on key elements of our bilateral relationship, US Ambassador said according to the US embassy. Bangladesh and the United States are likely to sign a trade agreement at yesterday, the sources added.

A Government-to-Government (G2G) contract for the purchase of Hydrographic and Oceanographic Survey Ship 'HMS Enterprise' was signed between Bangladesh and the United Kingdom (UK) at the Bangladesh Navy headquarters yesterday. Assistant Chief of the Bangladesh Navy Rear Admiral Md Shafiqur Rahman and United Kingdom's (UK's) Defence Ministry's Commercial Officer Ms. Nanise Qalobulawasaikabara signed the contract on behalf of their respective sides, said a release of Inter Services of Public Relations (ISPR) Directorate yesterday.

Adviser to the Ministry of Home Affairs and Agriculture has directed all concerned to sternly suppress any attempt to disrupt public security in the upcoming 13th Jatiya Sangsad (JS) elections. The Adviser said this while addressing the 'Law and order meeting for smooth conduct of the 13th Jatiya Sangsad Election and Referendum, 2026' held at the conference room of the Divisional Commissioner's Office yesterday.

The interim government has sought the cooperation of the Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights (OHCHR) to ensure a proper investigation and establishment of justice over the killing of Shaheed Sharif Osman Hadi. Following instructions from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, the Permanent Mission of Bangladesh in Geneva sent an official Note Verbale to the OHCHR on Friday (February 6), said the Chief Adviser's Press Wing yesterday. Through the note, Bangladesh formally requested technical and institutional assistance from the UN human rights office for the investigation into the killing, it added. A message received here from the Bangladesh Mission in Geneva stated

that the Ministry of Foreign Affairs will be informed immediately upon receiving any response from the OHCHR, the press wing said yesterday.

The Election Commission (EC) has requested the registered voters residing in Bangladesh who have enrolled through the Postal Vote BD app to complete their voting after receiving their ballots and submit the yellow envelope at the nearest post office by February 10, in order to participate in the 13th National Parliamentary Election and referendum scheduled to be held on February 12. The request was made in a message issued by the EC yesterday.

About 30,000 Bangladeshi women are working in the garment sector in Jordan and efforts are being made to increase this number. Managing Director (MD) of Bangladesh Overseas Employment and Services Limited (BOESL) shared the plan in an interview with BSS. Stating that employment abroad is being ensured through BOESL at a low cost, ethical and safe manner, the MD said when workers go abroad through BOESL, there is no opportunity for any middleman and the government takes direct responsibility for protecting the rights of the migrant workers. The Managing Director said BOESL is a 100 percent government institution, while thousands of workers go abroad through it every year.
