LGRD and Cooperatives Minister Mirza Fakhru Islam Alamgir said. Prime Minister Tarique Rahman's government will fulfill every promise it makes to the people. The Minister also said, Shaheed President Ziaur Rahman had initiated a green revolution in the country through canal excavation programmes and today his son, Prime Minister Tarique Rahman, is continuing that legacy by launching similar initiatives. The Minister said this while inaugurating a canal excavation programme on Neha River at Bhoularhat in Raipur Union of Sadar Upazila in Thakurgaon yesterday.

Deputy Speaker Barrister Kayser Kamal joined voluntary blood donors' reunion and discussion under the arrangement of Kalmakanda Youth Blood Donation Foundation at the Upazila Parishad hall room in Netrokona yesterday. 
Health and Family Welfare Minister Sardar Md. Sakhawat Husain has ordered the sealing of Doctors Care Hospital and Diagnostic Center at College Gate area of Shyamoli in the capital following allegations that surgeries were being conducted by fake doctors. The Minister took the prompt decision after an unannounced inspection yesterday, during which various irregularities were found. Arrangements were also made to quickly transfer admitted patients to other hospitals, considering their safety.
