Newsbrief

Prime Minister Tarique Rahman is expected to inaugurate the Family Card initiative, promised during the election campaign, on March 10. Social, Welfare and Women and Children Affairs Minister Dr. AZM Zahid Hossain disclosed this information yesterday. The Minister also said, the government is set to launch pilot phase of the Family Card programme with the ultimate aim of gradually bringing two crore families under monthly cash support.

Local Government, Rural Development and Cooperatives Minister Mirza Fakhru Islam Alamgir said, the party-BNP will move forward being inspired with the principles of 1952, 71, 90 and 2024. The Minister made the remarks while speaking as the chief guest at an Iftar programme organized by the NGO Eco-Social Development Organization (ESDO) in Thakurgaon yesterday. The Minister also said, announcing the start of implementing his electoral promises in the district. A team has already arrived to implement the Thakurgaon Medical College project as announced by Prime Minister Tarique Rahman, the Minister added. State Minister for Water Resources Forhad Hossain Azad was also present there as special guest.

Local Government, Rural Development and Cooperatives Minister Mirza Fakhru Islam Alamgir said, the new government is working to make state institutions, long rendered ineffective, functional and properly institutionalized once again. The Minister also confirmed that local government elections will be held on schedule. The Minister made the remarks while responding to journalists after laying the foundation stone of a multi-storey building at Hajipara Hafizia Madrasa in Thakurgaon yesterday.

Finance and Planning Minister Amir Khasru Mahmud Chowdhury said, education, health and employment would be prioritized in the upcoming budget. The Minister also said, the government is prioritizing the creation of more job opportunities, adding that both domestic and foreign investments are crucial to achieving this goal and are receiving equal importance. The Minister made the remarks while visiting the site designated for a proposed government hospital in the Jele Para area near Patenga Police Station in Chattogram yesterday.

Social Welfare and Women and Children Affairs Minister Dr. AZM Zahid Hossain provided free medical services to poor and underprivileged patients during a visit to his constituency in Dinajpur yesterday. The Minister personally provided prescriptions, medicines and necessary medical advice to the distressed people.

Bangladesh has strongly denounced Israel's recent land legislation aimed at annexing occupied Palestinian territory, with Foreign Minister Dr. Khalilur Rahman urging an immediate ceasefire in Gaza and reaffirming support for an independent Palestinian state. The Foreign Minister made the denounce while addressing the Open-Ended OIC Executive Committee Meeting at the Level of Foreign Ministers in Jeddah yesterday. The Minister categorically stated that the establishment of an independent and sovereign Palestinian state under the two-State solution based on the 1967 borders, with East Jerusalem as its capital, remains the only sustainable solution to the protracted crisis.

Land Minister Mizanur Rahman Minu has announced that initiatives are underway to introduce 'One-Stop Service Centers' modeled on developed countries to reduce public suffering by eliminating complexities and irregularities in land-related services. The Minister made the remarks while exchanging views with local journalists at Padma community center in Rajshahi yesterday. The Minister also said that the primary goal of modernizing the Ministry of Land is to ensure hassle-free services for ordinary citizens.

Information and Broadcasting Minister Zahir Uddin Swapan said, the media will define the boundaries of accountability while the state will ensure freedom within those limits. The Minister said this while speaking at a memorial programme organized by the Barishal Press Club yesterday.

Information and Broadcasting Minister Zahir Uddin Swapan said, family cards must be distributed with transparency by avoiding nepotism so the real beneficiaries can receive government assistance. The Minister also said, a team will be formed in each union under the leadership of the Upazila Nirbahi Officer (UNO), comprising the chairman and two social workers, for selecting beneficiaries. The Minister said this while speaking at an exchange of views meeting with district-level officials at the conference room of Barishal Circuit House yesterday.

Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs Minister Md. Asaduzzaman said, he wants to move forward along the path of the judiciary envisioned by all. The Minister said this while addressing an Iftar Mahfil organized by the Bangladesh Judicial Service Association in the capital yesterday. Drawing attention to the Judicial Service Association, the Minister stressed that the work of judges is highly sensitive.

Chattogram Hill Tracts Affairs Minister Dipen Dewan said, the main goal of the government is to reach the benefits of development to every person in the hilly region. The Minister said these replying to a query of reporters at the Rangamati Circuit House yesterday.

Education Minister ANM Ehsanul Hoque Milon said, teachers must obtain prior permission from the appropriate authorities before engaging in any profession outside their teaching duties, warning that action will be taken against those found violating the rule. The Minister told journalists after attending the monthly coordination meeting and law and order committee meeting at Kachua Upazila Parishad auditorium in Chandpur yesterday.

Posts, Telecommunications and Information Technology Minister Fakir Mahbub Anam announced that all airports, railway stations and high-speed vehicles across the country will be equipped with free Wi-Fi facilities, in line with Prime Minister Tarique Rahman's vision for the ICT sector. The Minister made the announcement while speaking after an exchange of views with district-level officials at the Tangail Deputy Commissioner's office yesterday.

State Minister for Commerce Md. Shariful Alam said that the government has maintained adequate stocks of TCB (Trading Corporation of Bangladesh) products to keep the commodity market stable. The State Minister came up with the remarks while speaking to journalists after inspecting various essential commodity shops at Bhairab Bazar in Kishoreganj yesterday.

State Minister for Foreign Affairs Shama Obaed Islam said, the government is working to ensure that Bangladeshi citizens can travel to India smoothly and the Indian side has shown a positive response. The State Minister told reporters at Fulbaria High School ground in Saltha upazila of Faridpur district yesterday.

State Minister for Fisheries and Livestock, Agriculture and Food Sultan Salahuddin Tuku said that under the leadership of Prime Minister Tarique Rahman, they are working with utmost sincerity from their respective positions for the welfare of the people. The State Minister made the remarks while speaking at an introduction meeting and Iftar gathering for the newly elected executive committee of the Tangail Press Club held at the club's VIP lounge yesterday.
