Newsbrief

President Mohammed Shahabuddin and Prime Minister Tarique Rahman offered their Eid-ul-Fitr prayers along with hundreds of people from all walks of life at the National Eidgah in the capital today. After the prayers, the President exchanged Eid greetings with Prime Minister. Country's noted personalities, including Chief justice of Bangladesh, Cabinet members, Chief Election Commissioner, Supreme Court judges, lawmakers, senior political leaders, diplomats and, high civil and military officials also offered prayers at the National Eidgah. Khatib of the Baitul Mukarram National Mosque Mufti Muhammad Abdul Malek conducted the Eid prayers and doa. A special munajat was offered seeking divine blessings for peace and progress of Bangladesh and welfare of the people as well as the Muslim Ummah.

President Mohammed Shahabuddin has greeted the countrymen on the holy Eid-ul-Fitr. In a message on Thursday the President said, the lessons of holy Eid-ul-Fitr would bring new enthusiasm and inspiration to all in the journey of building a new Bangladesh. The President said that an auspicious beginning of a discrimination-free, humane and democratic Bangladesh has taken place through immense sacrifice, endurance and selflessness. Describing Eid-ul-Fitr as the greatest religious festival of the Muslims, the President said the festival arrives with immense joy and happiness after a month-long fasting. In his message, the President also said the rich and the poor stand in the same row and share the happiness of Eid alike.

Prime Minister Tarique Rahman has extended his heartfelt greetings to the people of the country and Muslims around the world on the occasion of holy Eid-ul-Fitr. The Prime Minister said this in a message yesterday on the Eid-ul-Fitr. Describing the Eid-ul-Fitr as one of the two biggest religious festivals of Muslims the Premier said, 'Eid-ul-Fitr comes with the messages of joy, peace, harmony and brotherhood in our life after a month of fasting and restraint. Highlighting the significance of Ramadan the Prime Minister said, the holy month of Ramadan teaches restraint, sacrifice, service and self-purification. The Prime Minister emphasized that the true significance of the Eid lies in reflecting the teachings of Ramadan in individual, family, social and state life.

Stating that the holy month of Ramadan has departed after imparting lessons of sacrifice, piety and restraint, Prime Minister Tarique Rahman has called for sharing the happiness of the Eid-ul-Fitr with all, being inspired by the ideals of the Ramadan. The Prime Minister said this in a televised message yesterday on the occasion of the Eid-ul-Fitr. State-owned Bangladesh Television aired the message. The Prime Minister also conveyed heartfelt greetings and Eid Mubarak to the Muslim Ummah in Bangladesh and across the world.

Finance and Planning Minister Amir Khasru Mahmud Chowdhury announced that the Zia Memorial Museum in the Kazir Deuri area in Chattogram will be soon declared as a heritage site. Necessary renovation work will be carried out to address the infrastructure issues that have arisen due to long-term negligence of the previous fascist government, the Minister added. The Minister made these remarks during his visit to the Zia Memorial Museum near the Chattogram Circuit House yesterday.

Following the directive of the Prime Minister, State Minister for Railways Habibur Rashid inspected the Cox's Bazar Express at Kamalapur Railway Station yesterday. The State Minister boarded the train from Kamalapur and continued his journey to Chattogram. During the inspection, he talked with the passengers to assess and discuss ways to improve the quality of rail services. The State Minister expressed his firm commitment to further enhance the quality of railway services in the coming days.

Land Minister Mizanur Rahman Minu has distributed fish among students of various orphanages and madrasas in Rajshahi yesterday. A fish harvesting program was organized at a pond adjacent to the District Administration office. The pond fishes were later handed over to representatives of three orphanages and seven madrasas. Divisional Commissioner Dr. Bazlur Rashid, DIG of Rajshahi Range Mohammad Shahjahan and Deputy Commissioner Afia Akhtar were present at the event.

Expatriates' Welfare and Overseas Employment Minister Ariful Haque Chowdhury said, the government will always stand by the expatriates amid the ongoing war situation in the Middle East. The Minister said this while briefing the journalists at Hazrat Shahjalal International Airport yesterday after receiving the body of Mosharraf Hossain, who was killed in a missile strike in Saudi Arabia. Liberation War Affairs Minister Ahmed Azam Khan and State Minister for Foreign Affairs Shama Obayed Islam were also present at the airport at that time.

A total of 186 Bangladeshi nationals, evacuated from conflict-hit Iran, departed Baku yesterday for Dhaka. Foreign Ministry issued a press release in this regard yesterday.
