Newsbrief

Prime Minister Tarique Rahman has greeted the country's people and the Muslim Ummah on the occasion of the holy Lailatul Qadr. The Prime Minister also said, the Lailatul Qadr is a glorious and blessed night, while the Holy Quran was descended on this glorious night of the holy month of Ramadan. The Prime Minister said this in a message issued yesterday. The Prime Minister also prayed to Allah Almighty that infinite mercy and blessings of the holy Lailatul Qadr are poured in on all.

Prime Minister Tarique Rahman has provided an Eid gift of Taka 5,000 to each cleaner of the country's 12 city corporations ahead of the Eid al-Fitr. The Prime Minister handed over cheques to the Mayor and Administrators of different city corporations at his office in the Parliament Secretariat yesterday. Local Government, Rural Development and Cooperatives Minister Mirza Fakhrul Islam Alamgir, State Minister Mir Shahe Alam and Chattogram City Corporation Mayor Dr. Shahadat Hossain, among others, were present on the occasion.

Home Minister said, the country will continue to be governed strictly in accordance with the Constitution while maintaining commitment to the historic July National Charter. The Minister said this by taking floor in Jatiyo Sangsad yesterday, following the remarks of Leader of the Opposition in parliament and Ameer of Bangladesh Jammata-e-Islami Dr. Shafiqur Rahman on constitutional and legislative reforms in line with the 'July National Charter'.

Cultural Affairs Minister Nitai Roy Chowdhury called for building an inclusive society illuminated by knowledge, saying that destroying libraries and books is enough to destroy a nation. The Minister made the call while addressing the closing ceremony of the Amar Ekushey Book Fair at the Bangla Academy premises in the capital yesterday.

Commerce, Industries, Textiles and Jute Minister Khandaker Abdul Muktadir emphasized the government's decisive shift toward achieving tangible results in fostering a business-friendly environment to drive investment and employment. The Minister said this while speaking at a high-level view-exchange meeting with divisional and district administration officials and business leaders at the Chattogram Circuit House yesterday.

Commerce, Industries, Textiles and Jute Minister Khandaker Abdul Muktadir announced the formation of a Fact-Finding Committee to investigate the unacceptable price gap between wholesale and retail markets. The Minister made the announcement while speaking at a review meeting titled 'Middle East Conflict: Review of Consumer Goods Supply and Price Situation,' held at the Khatunganj Trade and Industries Association conference room in Chattogram yesterday.

Labour and Employment Minister Ariful Haque Chowdhury underscored the importance of constructive guidance and collaboration from the International Labour Organization to promote safe workplaces, uphold occupational health and safety, implement international labour standards and foster sustainable employment in Bangladesh. The Minister made the remarks during a courtesy meeting with ILO Country Director for Bangladesh, Max Tunon, at the conference room at his Ministry yesterday.

Civil Aviation and Tourism Minister Afroza Khanam inspected the VVIP and domestic terminals of Hazrat Shahjalal International Airport to review operational conditions and passenger services. The Minister conducted the on-site inspection at the country's main international gateway in the capital yesterday. During the visit, the Minister reviewed facilities and operational arrangements at both the VVIP and domestic terminals of the airport.

Liberation War Affairs Minister Ahmed Azam Khan said, the War of Liberation is the biggest and most glorious achievement in the thousand-year history of Bangladesh. The Minister vowed to conduct the Ministry activities by upholding the spirit of the War of Liberation. The Minister made the pledge while exchanging views with officials and employees of his Ministry yesterday.

Education Minister ANM Ehsanul Hoque Milon said, the government is considering necessary changes to the digital transfer system of primary school teachers to make the process more balanced and responsive to local needs. The Minister acknowledged the importance of the issue while responding to a query in the Jatiya Sangsad yesterday. During the question-and-answer session, the Minister also said that in the past there was no provision allowing primary school teachers to be transferred outside their respective areas.


State Minister for Foreign Affairs Shama Obaed Islam sought Russia's support for Bangladesh's candidature for the Presidency of the 81st Session of the United Nations General Assembly for the 2026–2027 term. The appeal was made when Ambassador of the Russian Federation to Bangladesh Alexander Grigoryevich Khozin paid a courtesy call on the State Minister at her Ministry in the capital yesterday. During the meeting, the Russian Envoy expressed confidence that the longstanding relations between Bangladesh and Russia would continue to grow stronger.

Dr. Rashed Al Mahmud Titumir, Prime Minister's Adviser on the Ministry of Finance and Planning, identified securing fuel oil funding and implementing urgent structural fiscal reforms as the government's foremost priorities. Speaking to reporters following a meeting at the Finance Division yesterday, he outlined a comprehensive strategy to maintain economic stability through energy security, transparent social safety nets and enhanced domestic revenue mobilisation.

The government has issued a gazette notification reassigning the portfolios of Prime Minister's Adviser Dr. Zahed Ur Rahman. Dr. Zahed Ur Rahman has been given the additional charge of the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting and the Ministry of Cultural Affairs alongside his existing responsibilities. The information was disclosed in a notification issued by the Cabinet Division yesterday.

The government has issued several guidelines for shopping malls and business establishments aimed at saving electricity. The decisions were taken at a meeting on Electricity and Energy Conservation held at Bidyut Bhaban in Dhaka yesterday. State Minister for Power, Energy and Mineral Resources Anindya Islam Amit presided over the meeting.

Chinese Ambassador to Bangladesh Yao Wen paid a courtesy call on Prime Minister's Defence Adviser Brigadier General (Retd) Dr. AKM Shamsul Islam at his office at the Armed Forces Division in Dhaka Cantonment yesterday. Prime Minister's Deputy Press Secretary Zahidul Islam Rony confirmed the matter.
