**Newsbrief**

Prime Minister Tarique Rahman has sought cooperation from all sections of society in building a safe and prosperous Bangladesh as desired by the people. The Prime Minister said this while joining a grand feast at the Dhaka Cantonment yesterday. Bangladesh Army's 25th East Bengal Regiment also known as 'Mrityunjoi' hosted the feast at Zia Colony in Dhaka Cantonment on the occasion of Eid-ul-Azha. Officers and soldiers participated in the event.

Prime Minister and BNP Chairman Tarique Rahman yesterday visited the graves of his parents at Zia Uddyan and offered munajat on the occasion of the Eid-ul-Azha. Prime Minister visited the grave of his younger brother Arafat Rahman Koko at Banani graveyard and offered prayer there. Later, the Prime Minister also visited the graves of the army officers killed in the BDR carnage and offered prayers there.

Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi has conveyed warm greetings to Prime Minister Tarique Rahman and the people of Bangladesh on the occasion of holy Eid-ul-Azha. Yesterday in a message sent to Tarique Rahman, the Indian Premier reaffirmed New Delhi's commitment to strengthening people-centric cooperation between the two neighbouring countries. In the message, Modi conveyed greetings on behalf of the people and the Government of India to the 'brotherly people' of Bangladesh, according to Indian High Commission in Dhaka.

Speaker Hafiz Uddin Ahmad, Bir Bikram, has expressed his optimism that democracy will get permanent shape and none will face persecution for their political belief under the tenure of the current BNP-led government. The Speaker said this while exchanging Eid greetings with administrative officials, political leaders, activists and the devotees after Eid-ul-Azha prayers at the central Eidgah ground in Lalmohan upazila of Bhola yesterday.

LGRD and Cooperatives Minister and BNP Secretary General Mirza Fakhrul Islam Alamgir has called for building a Bangladesh free from discrimination. The real lesson of sacrifice is standing beside the helpless people and serve the humanity, the Minister said this while talking to reporters after offering Eid prayers at Thakurgaon Central Eidgah yesterday.

Finance and Planning Minister Amir Khasru Mahmud Chowdhury stated that transition from a fragile economy to stability and progress will require time. The Minister said this while talking to journalists after performing Eid-ul-Azha prayers at his residence, Darus Salam Jame Mosque, in Chattogram yesterday. Noting that the prices of goods did not go up during this time Eid-ul-Azha, Finance Minister also mentioned that typically, prices increase during Eid-ul-Azha, yet this year it actually declined.

Home Minister Salahuddin Ahmed said, the current government is working with a commitment for national unity and building a developed and prosperous Bangladesh. The Minister said this while speaking to journalists after exchanging Eid greetings with the Prime Minister at the Prime Minister's Gulshan residence yesterday. The Minister said, people in Bangladesh have been enjoying a free, peaceful, and stable environment since August 5, 2024, allowing them to celebrate consecutive Eid festivals in a festive atmosphere. The Minister also urged the people to pray for continued peace, stability and prosperity of the nation.

Social Welfare and Women and Children Affairs Minister Abu Zafar Md. Zahid Hossain visited the Tejgaon Government Children's Home (Girls) in the capital yesterday on the occasion of the holy Eid-ul-Azha. The Minister inquired about the children's well-being and instructed the authorities to ensure proper food, medical care, overall living conditions, cleanliness, and food quality.

Industries, Commerce, Textiles and Jute Minister Khandakar Abdul Muktaadir said, there is no possibility of sacrificial hides being smuggled out of the country this year, expressing the government's determination to transform the leather sector from a struggling industry into a developed one. The Minister said this while talking to journalists after inspecting the procurement and trading activities of raw hides at Aminbazar in Savar yesterday.

Information and Broadcasting Minister Zahir Uddin Swapon said, peaceful coexistence of all regardless of religion and race must be ensured across the world. The Minister said this after offering Eid-ul-Azha prayers at the South Sarikal Madhyapara Darul Jannat Noor Eidgah ground in Gournadi upazila of Barishal yesterday.

Health and Family Welfare Minister Sardar Md. Sakhawat Husain said, strict legal action would be taken against Ad-din Hospital following the submission of the investigation report over the tragic deaths of children at the hospital's children's ward. Speaking to reporters after offering Eid prayers at the main Eidgah on the grounds of Monohardi Government Model Pilot High School in the upazila in Narsingdi yesterday, the Minister described the incident as 'deeply painful'.

Prime Minister's Adviser and BNP Senior Joint Secretary General Advocate Ruhul Kabir Rizvi met the family of slain child Ramisa Akter in their Pallabi residence yesterday on the day of holy Eid-ul-Azha. The Adviser also conveyed the Premier's condolences to the family.
