Newsbrief

Speaker Hafiz Uddin Ahmed Bir Bikram urged the treasury bench and the opposition to cooperate with each other to place a pro-people budget to bring comfort in public life. The Speaker also said that he would ensure that the opposition gets adequate time in the parliament to fulfill its responsibilities. The Speaker made the remarks while replying to a query of reporters at Bhola Circuit House yesterday.

Home Minister Salahuddin Ahmed said, the government has adopted a 'zero tolerance' policy against terrorism, drugs, extortion and all forms of criminal activities to ensure public safety and maintain law and order across the country ahead of Eid-ul-Azha. Speaking to journalists after visiting the National Operation Monitoring Center at Bangladesh Police Headquarters in Dhaka yesterday, the Minister said, law enforcement agencies remain fully prepared and vigilant to maintain nationwide peace and stability. The Minister also inspected the monitoring activities and provided directives to on-duty police officials.

Social Welfare, Women and Children Affairs Minister Abu Zafar Md. Zahid Hossain said, the government's goal is to transform the students into skilled workforce through modern and quality education. The Minister made the remarks while speaking at a cheque distribution programme for the underprivileged, helpless, sick, disabled people and poor students at Ghoraghat Upazila Parishad Auditorium in Dinajpur yesterday.

Water Resources Minister Shahiduddin Chowdhury Anee said, BNP is working beyond party affiliations, alleging that a particular party has been obstructing the government's activities over the past three months in a manner that goes against political decency and courtesy. The Minister made the remarks while exchanging views with party leaders and activists at Mandari Bazar in Chandraganj upazila in Lakshmipur yesterday.

Fisheries, Livestock and Agriculture Minister Mohammed Amin Ur Rashid said, rearing of sacrificial animals for Eid-ul-Azha is a major income sources for the marginal farmers and ranchers across the country. The Minister made the remarks while speaking to the reporters yesterday after inspecting the Neura cattle market at Cumilla Sadar Dakshin upazila ahead of the upcoming Eid-ul-Azha.

Disaster Management and Relief Minister Asadul Habib Dulu said, no one would remain homeless or neglected in the country as the government led by Prime Minister Tarique Rahman is working for the welfare of helpless and underprivileged people. The Minister made the remarks after handing over a house to three destitute siblings at the DC Park residential area in Lalmonirhat yesterday.

Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs Minister Md. Asaduzzaman said, judges in Bangladesh enjoy full independence in performing their judicial functions. The Minister said this while talking to newsmen at Shaikupa Upazila Health Complex in Jhenaidah yesterday. Referring to a comment made by NCP lawmaker Hasnat Abdullah, the Minister said, the remark amounts to contempt of court.

Dhaka South City Corporation (DSCC) has taken extensive preparations to remove sacrificial animal waste within eight hours during Eid-ul-Azha by deploying around 13,453 workers across the capital. DSCC Administrator Bir Muktiyoddha Md. Abdus Salam yesterday told reporters that the main waste removal operation would begin at 12 noon on Eid day, with a target to clear all first-day sacrificial waste within the next eight hours.

State Minister for Power, Energy and Mineral Resources Anindya Islam Amit visited the house of Rashed Khan, a Coordinator of the Anti-Discrimination Student Movement in Jashore and a parliamentary candidate for the Jashore-3 constituency in the 13th National Parliamentary Election. The State Minister also instructed the police administration to take strict legal action against those involved in the attack.

State Minister for Information and Broadcasting Yasser Khan Choudhury has urged everyone to dispose wastes of sacrificial animals at the designated locations during the holy Eid-ul-Azha to avert environment pollution. The State Minister made the call while speaking at a ceremony organized by the Mymensingh City Corporation at Town Hall yesterday. The State Minister also distributed Eid gift items among 4,737 underprivileged families ahead of the holy Eid.

Bangladesh Railway has introduced special coaches for women passengers on train services ahead of Eid-ul-Azha following the directive of Prime Minister Tarique Rahman. The special coaches have been added to the Dhaka-Sylhet-Dhaka route of Jayantika Express and the non-stop Dhaka-Chattogram-Dhaka route of Sonar Bangla Express to ensure safer and more comfortable travel for women passengers during the Eid rush. Bangladesh Railway Director General Md. Afzal Hossain formally inaugurated the service the day before yesterday by seeing off women passengers travelling in the special coach of Jayantika Express from Kamalapur Railway Station.

The government has taken special measures to ensure uninterrupted electricity supply across the country during Eid-ul-Azha. Power Division Secretary Mirana Mahrukh told this to reporters yesterday.

Director General of Rapid Action Battalion (RAB) Additional IGP Md. Ahsan Habib Palash said that they have taken the highest level of preparedness to maintain law and order across the country during the upcoming Eid-ul-Azha. The RAB Chief made the remarks while speaking after visiting the National Eidgah premises in Dhaka yesterday.
