Newsbrief

President Mohammed Shahabuddin and Prime Minister Tarique Rahman offered Eid-ul-Azha prayers along with hundreds of devotees at National Eidgah in Dhaka today. After the namaj the President and the Prime Minister joined a munajat with the devotees seeking blessings of the almighty for Muslim Ummah as well the nation.

President Mohammed Shahabuddin has extended heartfelt greetings to the people of the country and the Muslim Ummah across the world on the occasion of the holy Eid-ul-Azha, calling for the practice of sacrifice and humanity. In a message issued yesterday, the Head of State said, Eid-ul-Azha is not only one of the biggest religious festivals of Muslims but also a symbol of sacrifice, self-purification and humanity. Referring to the supreme sacrifice and obedience of Hazrat Ibrahim (AS) and Hazrat Ismail (AS), the President said, their ideals continue to inspire mankind to uphold faith, patience and devotion to the Almighty Allah. The President also called upon the affluent sections of the society to share the joy of Eid with underprivileged and distressed people.

Prime Minister Tarique Rahman greeted the countrymen and Muslims across the world on the occasion of the holy Eid-ul-Azha. In a message yesterday, the Prime Minister said, Eid-ul-Azha carries the profound message of sacrifice, piety, self-purification and devotion to the Almighty Allah, reminding believers of the highest ideals of faith. The Prime Minister said, the holy festival returns every year with renewed inspiration for spiritual upliftment and complete submission to the will of the Creator. The Prime Minister prayed to the Almighty Allah to accept the sacrifices of the faithful devotees and grant peace, security and stability to the motherland, the entire Muslim world and all humanity. The Prime Minister also prayed for global peace, harmony and security.

LGRD and Cooperatives Minister Mirza Fakhrul Islam Alamgir has extended Eid-ul-Azha greetings to Muslims in Bangladesh and around the world. In a message issued yesterday, the Minister wished the teachings of this sacred festival might awaken the spirit of sacrifice in the people's hearts and further strengthen the bonds of goodwill, harmony and brotherhood among all people, regardless of rich or poor, class or profession. The Minister also prayed that Almighty Allah might fill all lives with peace, welfare and prosperity.

LGRD and Cooperatives Minister Mirza Fakhrul Islam Alamgir said, agricultural land should not be wasted for urbanization. The Minister said this while visiting the proposed sites in a number of unions to establish a public university in Thakurgaon yesterday. The Minister also said, the BNP government has started work for establishment of a university, medical college, engineering college, nursing college, EPZ, etc. in Thakurgaon.

Social Welfare and Women and Children Affairs Minister Abu Zafar Md. Zahid Hossain said, no perpetrators of child or women abuse should be given shelter or leniency, as they are the enemies of the society. The Minister made the remark while distributing assistance and cheques to destitute, helpless, sick, disabled people and poor students at the Hakimpur Upazila Parishad Auditorium in Dinajpur yesterday.

Information and Broadcasting Minister Zahir Uddin Swapon said, communal harmony must be maintained in the country foiling any evil attempt to destroy it. The Minister told an Eid greeting exchange ceremony at Agailjhara upazila auditorium in Barishal yesterday. BNP's Agailjhara Upazila unit and its affiliated bodies organized the event. The Minister urged the government officials to carry out their responsibilities for the development of the country and the welfare of its citizens.

Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs Minister Md. Asaduzzaman said, the trial in the sensational Ramisa rape and murder case will begin on June 1. The Minister made the remarks while addressing at 'The Grand Finale' organized by Medha O Monon Mancha on the Shaikupa Government Degree College field in Jhenaidah yesterday. The Minister also said, steps would be taken promptly to address the long delays in preparing paper books for death row convicts.

State Minister for Local Government, Rural Development and Cooperatives (LGRD) Mir Shahe Alam said, the appointment of political administrators across all city corporations has significantly elevated the quality of civic services and brought visible improvements to urban management. The State Minister made these remarks while speaking to journalists after inspecting the ongoing preparations for the main Eid-ul-Azha congregation at the Jatiya Eidgah yesterday. Dhaka South City Corporation (DSCC) Administrator valiant Freedom Fighter M Abdus Salam accompanied him during the visit.

State Minister for Information and Broadcasting Yasser Khan Choudhury has urged people to dispose of sacrificial animal waste at designated places during Eid-ul-Azha to prevent environmental pollution. The State Minister also urged citizens not to dump waste into drains by any means as it could block the drainage system creating severe risk of waterlogging during the monsoon in respective areas. The State Minister made the remarks while addressing a programme organized by Mymensingh City Corporation at Tarek Smriti Auditorium of the Town Hall in Mymensingh yesterday.

The Election Commission (EC) is set to introduce major reforms to local government election rules, including a ban on campaign posters, removal of EVM provisions and abolition of party symbols, as part of efforts to ensure neutral and peaceful polls ahead of the upcoming local government elections. Election Commissioner Abdur Rahmani Masud told BSS in an exclusive interview yesterday. The Election Commissioner also said, the EC has already taken the initiative to amend the local government election regulations and several significant changes are being incorporated into the revised rules, which are expected to be finalized after Eid and completed within June.

Bangladesh and Belgium have discussed ways to capitalize on renewed political momentum to deepen bilateral cooperation, particularly in research and innovation, for the mutual benefit of the two friendly countries. Bangladesh Ambassador to Belgium Masudul Alam held separate meetings on May 26 with William Asselborn, Director for Asia and Oceania at the Belgian Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Marc Lemaître, Director-General for Research and Innovation of the European Union (EU), according to the Bangladesh Mission in Brussels. During the meeting with Asselborn, the two sides reviewed issues of mutual interest and discussed the future course of bilateral engagement, as relations between Bangladesh and Belgium continue to deepen steadily.

Md. Lutfar Rahman, widely and affectionately known as Ek Taka Master (the One-Taka Teacher), received Eid gifts from Prime Minister Tarique Rahman in recognition of his outstanding contribution to educating underprivileged local children. On behalf of the Prime Minister, Gaibandha Deputy Commissioner (DC) Muhammad Masudur Rahman Mollah yesterday visited Lutfar Rahman's home in Baguria village under Gidari union of Sadar upazila in Gaibandha to hand over the special gifts ahead of the upcoming Eid-ul-Adha.

Dhaka Metropolitan Police has adopted a coordinated, technology-based and multi-dimensional security plan to ensure safety during Eid-ul-Azha congregations and protect residential and commercial areas that may remain vacant during the holidays. DMP Commissioner Mosleh Uddin Ahmed said this in a briefing after inspecting security arrangements at the National Eidgah Ground in Dhaka yesterday.
