Newsbrief

Prime Minister and BNP Chairman Tarique Rahman said that his government is committed to fulfilling all expectations of the country's people. The Prime Minister also sought all-out cooperation from the party leaders, workers and supporters in running a 'successful government stating that 'very difficult times lie ahead'. The Prime Minister made the remarks while taking part in a discussion at the Krishibid Institution Bangladesh Auditorium in the capital yesterday. The ruling Bangladesh Nationalist Party (BNP) organized the discussion marking the 45th martyrdom anniversary of Shaheed President Ziaur Rahman.

BNP Secretary General and Local Government, Rural Development and Cooperatives Minister Mirza Fakhrul Islam Alamgir said, Ziaur Rahman and Bangladesh are inseparable, adding that the country's Liberation War began with Zia's declaration of independence and that he later played a pivotal role in rebuilding the nation. The Minister also said that after independence, people placed their trust in Ziaur Rahman and turned to him when they were searching for new leadership. The Minister made the remarks while presiding over a discussion at the Krishibid Institution Bangladesh Auditorium in Farmgate area yesterday, marking the 45th death anniversary of BNP founder and former President Ziaur Rahman.

Home Minister Salahuddin Ahmed warned of launching stringent drives against violence-mongers, saying 'Jungle Salimpur will no longer remain a sanctuary for criminals and the government has no plan to evict any innocent individuals from the area now'. The Home Minister made the remarks while briefing the press during his visit to the Jungle Salimpur area yesterday. Jungle Salimpur, a hard to access hilly area under Sitakunda upazila of Chattogram, besides Dhaka-Ctg highway with hundreds of illegally built slums and half-concrete houses, has turned into a criminals' den for more than one and half a decade. A RAB officer was killed last year and a number of law enforcers were injured as the armed criminals attacked them while conducting drives at different times to bring the areas under administrative control by freeing it from the dominance of anti-social elements.

Social Welfare and Women and Children Affairs Minister Abu Zafar Md. Zahid Hossain has exchanged post-Eid greetings with the underprivileged children at his official residence in Dhaka yesterday. Children from Mirpur Shishu Paribar (Boys), Tejgaon Shishu Paribar (Girls), Azimpur Chhotomoni Nibash and the Shishu Bikash Kendra attended the event, spending an enjoyable afternoon with the Minister and sharing the festive spirit of Eid. At that time, the Minister exchanged greetings with the children, listened to their Eid experiences and personally hosted the event.

Environment, Forest and Climate Change Minister Abdul Awal Mintoo said, if necessary, they will go to court for realizing compensation for farmers harmed by Cumilla Export Processing Zone (EPZ) waste disposal in canal. The Minister said this while addressing a discussion at Bijoypur Mohila College in Cumilla yesterday with farmers affected by the discharge of waste from the Cumilla EPZ into natural canals.

Environment, Forest and Climate Change Minister Abdul Awal Mintoo said, Shaheed President Ziaur Rahman made a unique contribution to the country by establishing multi-party democracy at a time when democratic practices were absent. The Minister told a discussion at the Sonagazi Municipal Auditorium in Feni yesterday. Sonagazi Upazila and Municipal BNP organized the marking the 45th martyrdom anniversary of Ziaur Rahman. with Upazila BNP Convener Zainal Abedin Bablu in the chair.

Cheques worth Taka 50 lakh from the Prime Minister's Relief Fund were distributed among 16 institutions in Natore yesterday. Whip Advocate Md. Ruhul Quddus Talukder Dulu distributed the cheques at his office in the district town.

Six Bangladeshi Peacekeepers who lost their lives while serving under the UN flag in Abyei will be posthumously honoured with the prestigious 'Dag Hammarskjöld Medal' at the United Nations Headquarters on June 5. The medals will be awarded by UN Secretary-General António Guterres during a ceremony marking the International Day of United Nations Peacekeepers, according to a UN press release yesterday. The six Bangladeshi Peacekeepers are Md. Jahangir Alam, Md. Sobuj Mia, Md. Masud Rana, Md. Mominul Islam, Shamim Reza and Santo Mondol. They were killed in a drone strike on December 13, 2025 while serving with the United Nations Interim Security Force for Abyei.
