President Mohammed Shahabuddin called for creating mass awareness and ensuring strict enforcement of relevant laws to prevent tobacco addiction. The President made the call in a message yesterday marking the 'World No-Tobacco Day'.

Prime Minister Tarique Rahman urged city dwellers to be aware of waste removal in Dhaka city. The Prime Minister made the remarks while speaking at a food and clothes distribution programme at Jurain in Dhaka yesterday on the occasion of the 45th martyrdom anniversary of Shaheed President Ziaur Rahman, Bir Uttam.
