## Newsbrief

Prime Minister Tarique Rahman stressed adopting innovative and sustainable production methods for survival in competitive global market, saying consumers are now far more aware than before. The Prime Minister said in a message on the eve of the World Accreditation Day 2026 yesterday. About the day, the Prime Minister said, The World Accreditation Day reminds us every year of the importance of safety, quality, and trust in the products and services we use in our daily lives.

BNP Secretary General and LGRD Minister Mirza Fakhru Islam Alamgir said that BNP founder Shaheed President Ziaur Rahman was a man of extraordinary brilliance who pulled a devastated nation back from the brink of collapse. The Minister made the remarks while speaking at a special prayer ceremony and discussion marking the 45th martyrdom anniversary of Shaheed President Ziaur Rahman, organised by Bangladesh Bouddha Kristi Prachar Sangha at the Dharmarajika Buddhist Temple in the Basabo yesterday.

Local Government, Rural Development and Cooperatives Minister Mirza Fakhru Islam Alamgir said effective and modern water management is very important for ensuring public health and protecting the environment in urban areas. The Minister made the remarks while visiting the under-construction Gandharbapur Water Treatment Plant at Rupganj in Narayanganj to ensure safe and sustainable water supply for the capital yesterday.

Home Minister Salahuddin Ahmed said the government is taking strides to make the police more service-oriented and people-friendly by boosting its moral strength and professionalism. The Minister made the remarks while briefing journalists at the conference room of the Ministry of Home Affairs at the Secretariat yesterday.

Power, Energy and Mineral Resources Minister Iqbal Hassan Mahmood has asked the organizations concerned to make a working paper to make the country's electricity transmission and distribution systems safer, smarter, and more modern as part of preparations for entering the era of nuclear power. During the meeting, the Minister instructed Power Grid Bangladesh PLC chief engineer and relevant officials to present a detailed concept and working paper on smart grid systems. The Minister made the remarks while speaking at a review meeting held at the ministry yesterday.

A delegation from the Turkish Cooperation and Coordination Agency met Social Welfare and Women and Children Affairs Minister Abu Zafar Md Zahid Hossain at his office in the Bangladesh Secretariat yesterday. TIKA Vice President Dr Ali Ercan led the delegation during the meeting, said an official handout. During the meeting, both sides discussed in detail the strengthening of bilateral relations, particularly the expansion of TIKA's assistance in the areas of social welfare and women and children's development. The Minister praised various development projects implemented in Bangladesh through TIKA and expressed hope for greater cooperation in the future in the fields of health, education, skills development, and welfare projects for women and children.

Foreign Minister Dr Khalilur Rahman paid tribute to the soldiers who sacrificed their lives during the Second World War by laying a wreath at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier in Moscow. The Foreign Minister laid the wreath at the historic memorial in the Russian capital as part of his official visit to Russia yesterday.

The results of the Secondary School Certificate (SSC) and equivalent examinations will be published by July 20, with all education boards across the country having been given specific and final instructions in this regard. Education and Primary and Mass Education Minister Dr A N M Ehsanul Hoque Milon disclosed this while responding to questions from journalists at a press conference held at the conference room of the Ministry of Education yesterday.

Health and Family Welfare Minister Sardar Md Sakhawat Hossain said Bangladesh's pharmaceutical sector is steadily strengthening its position in the global market, with locally produced medicines now being exported to more than 140 countries. The Minister told this to journalists in the ministry's conference room at Bangladesh Secretariat yesterday.

State Minister for Foreign Affairs Shama Obaed Islam sought Türkiye's support in implementing educational programmes for homeless street children and strengthening climate resilience in vulnerable regions. The State Minister made the appeal during a meeting with high-level delegation of the Turkish Cooperation and Coordination Agency (TIKA) at the foreign ministry, according to a ministry's press release yesterday.

Bangladesh sought Spain's support at the United Nations General Assembly (UNGA) for its smooth graduation from the Least Developed Country (LDC) category. The appeal was made when Spanish Ambassador to Bangladesh Gabriel Maria Sistiaga Ochoa de Chinchetru called on State Minister for Foreign Affairs Shama Obaed Islam at the foreign ministry, said a ministry's press release yesterday.

State Minister for Land Barrister Mir Mohammad Helal Uddin paid surprise visits to the Aminbazar and Ashulia Revenue Circle offices in Savar yesterday and uncovered a number of irregularities in service delivery, staff attendance and administrative management. During the inspection, the State Minister reviewed service activities, attendance records and overall administrative operations at the two revenue circles.

State Minister for Primary and Mass Education Bobby Hajjaj announced that a pilot programme to distribute free uniforms, shoes, and school bags to more than 350,000 students in government primary schools across the country will begin in July–August. The State Minister said Prime Minister Tarique Rahman will inaugurate the programme before the government completes its first 180 days in office. The State Minister said this in a press conference held in the conference room of the Ministry of Textiles and Jute at the Secretariat yesterday.

Prime Minister's Defence Adviser Brigadier General (ret'd) Dr AKM Shamsul Islam called for launching Bangladesh's own satellite and maximizing the use of space research and remote sensing technologies to strengthen national security, defence capabilities and disaster management. During a visit to the Bangladesh Space Research and Remote Sensing Organization (SPARRSO) at Agargaon, the Adviser directed the authorities concerned to take necessary initiatives for launching a national satellite and enhancing SPARRSO's role in border surveillance, strategic mapping and geospatial intelligence. The Defence Adviser said the SPARRSO-generated satellite data and research outputs should be made more accessible for the operational and research activities of the Bangladesh Army, Navy and Air Force, according to a press release issued by the Inter Services Public Relations (ISPR) Directorate yesterday.

Prime Minister's Education Adviser Mahdi Amin said the government plans to make technical and vocational education compulsory from Grade Six in order to make the country's education system skill-based and employment-oriented. The Adviser made the remarks while speaking in a press conference at the Secretariat on various activities in education sector yesterday.
