Newsbrief

Prime Minister Tarique Rahman said his government intends to integrate sports, culture, and innovation into the education system to make the students as worthy citizens of the country to cope with the technology-driven world. The Prime Minister told a national "Startup, Science Project and Innovation Idea Showcasing" at Bangladesh-China Friendship International Conference Center yesterday.

Prime Minister Tarique Rahman will attend a daylong national-level 'Startup, Science Project and Innovation Idea Showcasing' programme featuring the participation of secondary-level teachers and students at the Bangladesh-China Friendship Conference Center at 2pm today. The Premier will also distribute awards to meritorious teachers for their contribution to quality education and the students with innovative quality on the occasion as the chief guest, said an official handout yesterday.

Prime Minister Tarique Rahman called upon the people to develop the habit of planting at least one tree every year during the monsoon season, saying that observing a single commemorative day is not enough to fulfil environmental responsibilities. The Prime Minister made the remarks when the Premier was inaugurating tree plantation campaign at secondary educational institutions across the country from Bangladesh-China Friendship International Conference Center in the capital's Sher-e-Bangla Nagar yesterday.

Prime Minister Tarique Rahman pledged to restore discipline in the country's economy expressing his government's commitment to recover the money laundered abroad as quickly as possible. The Prime Minister proposed several people-friendly amendments to the proposed national budget including reducing the tax burden on ordinary citizens, withdrawing the controversial provision of whitening black money and promoting domestic industries and private higher education. The Prime Minister presented the proposals to Finance and Planning Minister Amir Khasru while participating in the budget debate in the House yesterday.

Prime Minister Tarique Rahman described the proposed national budget for 2026-27 fiscal as a 'life centric' one which focused providing at least some relief and comfort to people from all walks of life. The Prime Minister expressed this view while taking part in the general discussion on the proposed budget for Fiscal Year 2026-27 in the House with Speaker Hafiz Uddin Ahmad, Bir Bikram in the chair yesterday.

Prime Minister Tarique Rahman categorically said that the Teesta barrage master plan will be implemented at any cost to ensure the country's water security, support agriculture and improve the livelihoods of people in the northern region describing it as a national priority. The Prime Minister said while taking part in the general discussion on the proposed budget for fiscal year of 2026-27 in the House yesterday.

Prime Minister Tarique Rahman urged the authorities of telecom operator Banglalink to consider reducing the price of internet. The Premier made the call when Augie Fabela, Chairman of VEON, the parent company of Banglalink, paid a courtesy call on him at the prime minister's office at Sangsad Bhaban yesterday.

Prime Minister Tarique Rahman has urged students to prepare themselves to work for the welfare of the country. The Prime Minister made the call while speaking with a group of students who had come to observe the budget session of National Parliament yesterday. The Prime Minister's spouse Dr. Zubaida Rahman was also present.

Local Government, Rural Development and Cooperatives Minister and BNP Secretary General Mirza Fakhru Islam Alamgir said opposition members of parliament (MPs) would receive an allocation of around Tk 20 crore for development works in their respective constituencies. The Minister made the remarks when delivering a statement under Rule 300 of the Rules of Procedure in the National Parliament yesterday.

Labor and Employment Minister Ariful Haque Choudhury said child labor must be eliminated through practical and sustainable initiatives and start from our own homes. The Minister made the remarks while speaking as the chief guest at a discussion held at the Institution of Agriculturists auditorium yesterday.

Education Minister Dr. ANM Ehsanul Hoque Milon said equipping the new generation with modern technical skills will enable a prosperous Bangladesh to stand tall on the world stage. Addressing an event as a special guest at the Bangladesh-China Friendship Conference Center in Sher-e-Bangla Nagar, the Minister noted that Prime Minister Tarique Rahman was deeply impressed by the talent and ingenuity displayed by the country's young scientists yesterday. The Ministry of Education organized the event to mark a nationwide secondary-level tree-planting initiative, alongside the exhibition and award ceremony for the national-level 'Startup, Science Project and Innovation Idea Showcasing' competition.

State Minister for Primary and Mass Education Bobby Hajjaj said the government seeks to work in coordination with NGOs through effective partnerships to improve the quality of primary education. The State Minister said while addressing the Geo-NGO Collaboration Dialogue as the chief guest at the BRAC Center in the city, said a press release yesterday.
