Newsbrief

Prime Minister Tarique Rahman said that it is possible to fully restore the people's confidence and trust in the country's healthcare system through the sincere and humanitarian approach of doctors and healthcare workers towards patients, and by providing proper treatment. The Prime Minister made these remarks while addressing a views exchange meeting titled "DMCians' thoughts on modernisation of Bangladesh's Healthcare System", organised at the Dhaka Medical College auditorium yesterday on the occasion of its 81st day. Earlier, the Prime Minister inaugurated the 'Dhaka Medical College (DMC) Day-2026' marking the 80th anniversary of the college.

Prime Minister Tarique Rahman visited BNP Media Cell Convener Professor Dr. Moudud Hossain Alamgir Pavel, who is undergoing treatment at Continental Hospital in Gulshan yesterday. During the visit, the Prime Minister spoke with the physicians treating Prof. Pavel and the Prime Minister was briefed on the latest physical condition of the patient. The Prime Minister wished Prof. Pavel a speedy recovery and directed the concerned authorities to ensure that he receives the highest standard of medical care.
