
**Subject: English I & II**

Let us see and learn some important Components of a sentence structure in the next slide

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
**Subject**: Subject works as the performer of verb of a sentence. It is always a noun or pronoun. **Example: Jamal, Karim, He, She, They, I, We, Our house, This house, The Car, A Car, The Parrot, It, Gerunds (Walking, Swimming, Smoking, verb+ing...)**

# Verbs

**Auxiliary Verbs** (am, is, are, was, were, have, has, had, been, will, shall)

Transitive Verbs (eat, play, catch, kill, murder, write etc. )


In-transitive Verb (go, rise, run, jump etc. )



**Objects**: Objects are the receiver of a verb in a sentence. Generally it stays in the back end of a sentence.  
Example: us, it, any name, her, his, mine, them etc.

- **Adjective Complements**: good boy, nice work, wonderful man, excellent worker, good student, beautiful girl, old man, elder brother, younger sister, two dozen fruits etc.

- **Adverbials**: in the East, in the West, regularly, irregularly, wonderfully, humbly, in the field, with some friends, very strongly etc.



### **Example:**

- Subject + auxiliary verb + Transitive Verb + Object. (He is playing Cricket.)
- Subject + auxiliary verb + Intransitive Verb + adverbial. (He is playing in the field./ The Sun is rising in the East.)
- Subject + Modal verb + Transitive Verb + Object. (He can do it./ We must finish the job.)
