All bidders must have operation and maintenance facilities in Employer's Country for after sales service support. The sites of sub-station like DACOP-3 (SRINAGAR), KOYRA-2 (2 No. KOYRA) and DUMURIA-5 (MADARTOLA) of Khulna PBS are situated in the coastal area. These areas experience a number of disastrous Cyclone and Water-Surge in every year. Due to the climate change, it can be assumed that, more severe natural calamities will occur in these areas in the coming years. The proposed Sub-stations are the key installation of the power network under Khulna PBS. Considering the present and future climatic condition the 'Earth Filling Height', 'Control Room and Transformer Pad' should be designed in accordance with the water surge and Cyclone intensity.
