1. The People's Republic of Bangladesh has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Bangladesh Road Safety Project. The Roads and Highways Department, an implementing agency of the Client, intends to apply a portion of the proceeds of this credit to eligible payments under the contract for 'Engineering Improvement on National Road Safety Demonstration Pilots - N4 and N6'.
2. The Roads and Highways Department now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for the above mentioned package.
3. Bidding will be conducted through international competitive procurement using Request for Bids (RFB) as specified in the World Bank's "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers-Procurement in Investment Projects Financing" November 2020 ("Procurement Regulations"), and is open to all eligible Bidders as defined in the Procurement Regulations.
4. Interested eligible Bidders may obtain further information from The Office of the Project Director, Road Safety Project, Room-207, Block-A, Sarak Bhaban, Tejgaon, Dhaka.
5. The Bidding document in English may be purchased by interested eligible Bidders upon the submission of a written application to the address below and upon payment of a nonrefundable fee in the currency of BDT or USD as mentioned below. The method of payment will be cash or electronic wire transfer to the bank account of the Employer (given below) or Pay Order (from any scheduled commercial bank in Bangladesh). The document fee and delivery terms are as follows:
 - (a) Nonrefundable fee: BDT 5,000 (BDT five thousand only), delivery of Bidding Document by hand from the office of the Project Director; or
 - (b) Nonrefundable fee: BDT 7,000 (BDT Seven thousand only), delivery of Bidding Document through courier service within Bangladesh from the office of the Project Director; or
 - (c) Nonrefundable fee: BDT 24,000 (BDT Twenty four thousand) or USD 197 (USD One hundred ninety seven only), delivery of Bidding Document through airmail outside Bangladesh from the office of the Project Director.
 - (d) Within 3 working days of receipt of the required fee in the Employer's bank account, the Employer will dispatch the bidding documents through courier service and send a copy of the courier service order receipt through reply email to the bidder's email address, which the

- bidder may use to track the delivery. The Employer shall not be responsible in case of late or incorrect delivery by the courier service company.
6. Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before 02:00 PM June 16, 2025. Electronic bidding will not be permitted. Late Bids will be rejected. The outer Bid envelopes marked "ORIGINAL BID," and the inner envelopes marked "TECHNICAL PART" will be publicly opened in the presence of the Bidders' designated representatives and anyone who chooses to attend, at the address below on 02:05 PM June 16, 2025. All envelopes marked "FINANCIAL PART" shall remain unopened and will be held in safe custody of the Employer until the second public bid opening (financial bid opening).
 7. All Bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security of BDT 29,000,000.00 (BDT Twenty nine million only) or USD 240,000.00 (USD Two hundred forty thousand only) or an equivalent amount in any freely convertible foreign currency.
 8. All Bids must be accompanied by a Sexual Exploitation and Abuse (SEA) and/or Sexual Harassment (SH) Declaration.
 9. Attention is drawn to the Procurement Regulations requiring the Borrower to disclose information on the successful bidder's beneficial ownership, as part of the Contract Award Notice, using the Beneficial Ownership Disclosure Form as included in the bidding document.
 10. A pre-bid meeting will be held on May 20, 2025 at 11am at Room#A-201, Sarak Bhaban, Tejgaon, Dhaka, Bangladesh.


