Project Implementation Unit (PIU) intends to apply part of the proceeds for the Consulting Services to assist PIU, Roads and Highways Department and Bangladesh Police for implementing the project.

Preferably, the single applicant or all Joint Venture (JV) members are at least five years old.

Similar experience: At least one experience in ITMIDS systems design, rollout and support services or similar nature services; the minimum contract value of each contract of the services is BDT 6,00,00,000 (USD 0.6 million). Please provide completion certificates from the client. Experience in developing countries will be an added advantage.
 3. Managerial and organizational capabilities: Whether the firm adheres to the requirements of the International Good Practices or has a Code of Ethics. Whether the firm is a small, specialized firm with limited staff and access to a pool of experts or a large firm with in-house experts. Please provide supporting relevant documents in these regards.
