

Sub: Permission to enter all FDMN Camps in Cox's Bazar to conduct Research work.

Ref: Your letter dated 11 December, 2025.

In response to the above mentioned letter, this office is pleased to grant you permission to enter all FDMN Camps in Cox's Bazar to conduct a research titled "Effects of Reproductive Coercion on Women's Healthcare Access and Maternal / Newborn Health in Rohingya refugees, Bangladesh". This permission will remain valid till 15 March, 2025 under the following terms and conditions:

1. You are requested to inform and coordinate with the concerned CiCs (Camp in-Charges) before commencing the activities;
2. You must follow the applicable Govt. Policy, Rules and Laws;
3. You are not allowed to enter the camps during the government holidays;
4. You must leave the camps before 3.30 pm;
5. The Research must refrain from including any context that could harm the interests of Bangladesh or tarnish the reputation of the country and its government. Additionally, any statement that supports armed Rohingya groups should be excluded;
6. You must not publish any report before sharing the research findings with this office.
