In response to the above-mentioned subject and letter, this office is pleased to grant you permission to enter all FDMN Camps in Cox's Bazar to conduct "Cultural and Systemic Constraints of Service Access by Rohingya Refugee Women GBV Survivors in Cox's Bazar Camps." This permission shall remain valid till 30 ~~April~~^{May} 2026 subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. You are requested to inform and coordinate with the concerned CiCs (Camp in-Charges) before commencing the activities;
2. Relevant Govt. Policy, Rules and Laws must be followed;
3. You are not allowed to enter the camps during the government holidays;
4. You must leave the camps before 3.30 pm;
5. No statements or Comments that undermine the interests of the government, Local communities or the Rohingya may be included in the report;
6. The content/report must be submitted to RRRC Office as well as to CiC Office, before publishing;
7. This office may revoke this permission anytime without any prior notice

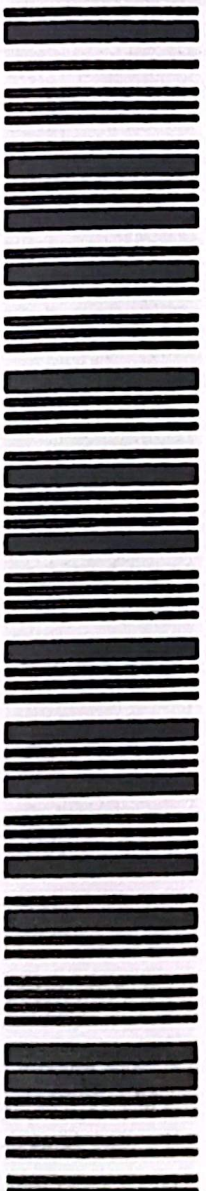
