
**Sub:** Permission to enter all FDMN camps in Cox's Bazar and Bashanchar camp to conduct Monitoring Assessment work

In response to the above-mentioned subject and letter, this office is pleased to grant permission to enter all FDMN Camps Ukhiya, Taknaf in Cox's Bazar and Bashanchar camp, Hatiya, Noakhali to conduct "Third party Monitoring of UNICEF Programme interventions in Cox's Bazar". This permission shall remain valid till 30 April 2027 subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. You are requested to inform and coordinate with the concerned CiCs (Camp in-Charges) before commencing the activities;
2. You must follow the applicable Govt. Policy, Rules and Laws;
3. You are not allowed to enter the camps during the government holidays;
4. You must leave the camps before 3.30 pm;
5. The content/report must be submitted to RRRRC Office as well as to CiC Office, before publishing;
6. No statements or Comments that undermine the interests of the government, Local communities or the Rohingya may be included in the report;
7. This office may revoke this permission anytime without any prior notice;
