 - a) Core Business and Years in Business.
 - b) Relevant Experience: Applicants should demonstrate experience in similar assignments in last ten years.
 - c) Technical and Organizational Capabilities.


6. An Applicant may associate with other consultant(s) to enhance their qualifications, however this is not mandatory.
