



Patenga (Jamboree Ground)



The site, between the sea and the hills, is suitable for camping and adventure. It will have all facilities required for camping including sub-camp facilities, potable drinking water, showers and toilets, staff dining, parking, GDV, cultural activities, contingent stands, jamboree headquarters, medical facilities (except medication, x-ray and hospitalisation), ambulance services & site security.

A coral island, 30km from Teknaf and accessible only by water transportation


Chittagong Port

Boating on Foy's lake




5km from Jamboree Site
