

Messenger of Peace (Mop)

Messengers of Peace is a flagship initiative of World Scouting which inspires Scouts around the world to take action in their communities by contributing to peace and sustainable development, involving nearly all 172 National Scout Organizations, and inspired more than 16 million projects and actions totalling over 2.3 billion hours of community service contributed towards the SDGs since 2010.



Scouting for street children known as TTL scouting, through WSB/APR Ticket to Life Project started in Bangladesh in 2006. It is estimated that the number of street children in Bangladesh to be around 670,000 of whom 36% are in Dhaka city alone.

It is essential to make them confident of their own capacity and bring them in the main stream of the society. Their position in the society can be upgraded by creating awareness among the community people. Scouting is the appropriate movement to address their vulnerability and turn them as important citizen of the country.

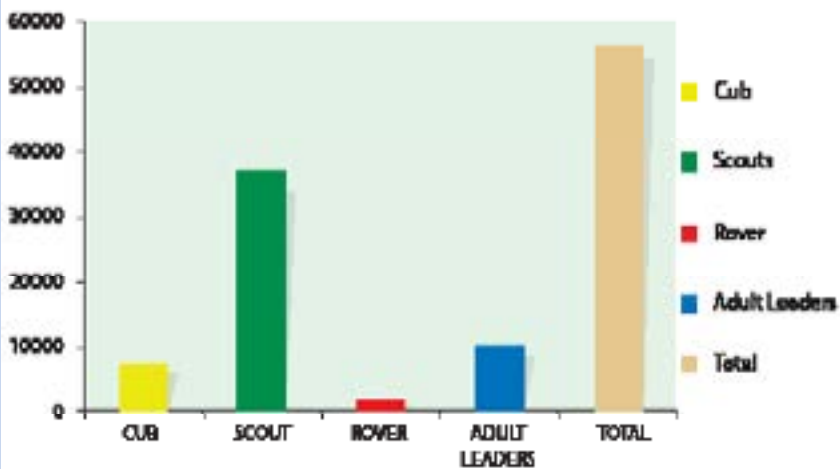

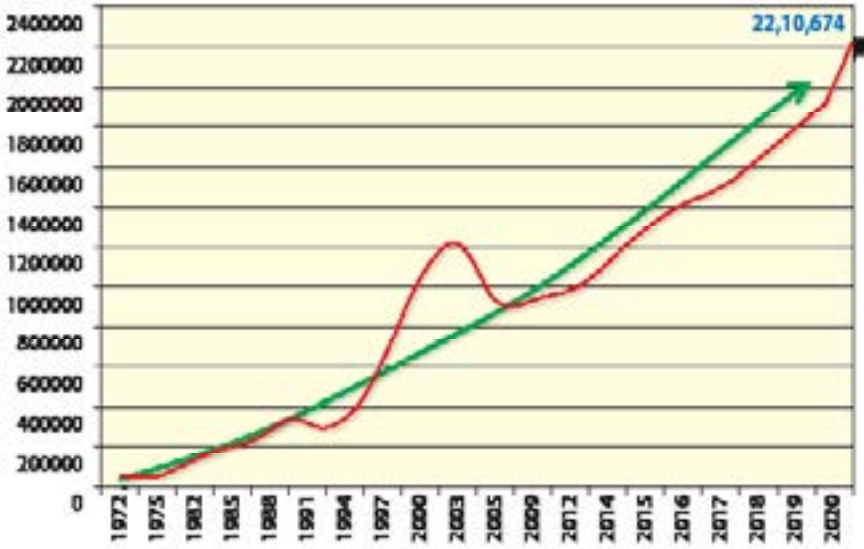
SCOUT POPULATION 1972

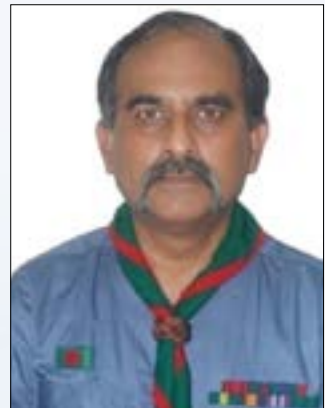

The World Scout Foundation

The World Scout Foundation itself is an international non-profit institution, incorporated under Swiss law, and based in Geneva, Switzerland. It was established on 14 February 1969, and then re-organised into its current form in 1977, under the patronage of His Majesty Carl XVI Gustaf, The King of Sweden, who has been the Honorary Chairman since 1977.

The APR Scout Foundation

The APR Scout Foundation was established in 1991 and raised funds in the course of more than 25 years. The Foundation envisions the growth of quality Scouting in member countries and to strengthen self-reliance. To achieve this, grants and non-interest bearing loans are provided to member countries for various projects. Grants are offered for community-based projects while loans are offered for income-generating ventures, infrastructural and entrepreneurship proposals.

History of Bangladesh Scouts Foundation

The journey of Bangladesh Scouts Foundation started in 1994. The Bangladesh Scouts Foundation was formed to organize and raise funds for the smooth running of various activities of the Bangladesh Scouts. Subsequently, the Bangladesh Scouts Foundation Policy 2007

was adopted. In the light of this policy, all the activities of Bangladesh Scouts Foundation are being conducted at present. Bangladesh Scouts Foundation is on the verge of final approval of the revised policy-2021.



Initially it started its journey in 1994 with 4 Fellows and 6 Associate Members, but now the number of members of Bangladesh Scouts Foundation in different categories is 445. Membership of Bangladesh Scouts Foundation can be obtained from a minimum of Tk 10,000 to a maximum of Tk 15,00,000
