Invitation for Applications to Participate in the First National Scout Jamboree 2026, Bhutan

The Bhutan Scouts Association will host the First National Scout Jamboree 2026 from 26–30 May 2026 at the National Scouts Centre, Paro, Bhutan. The Jamboree is organized in commemoration of the 70th Birth Anniversary of His Majesty the Fourth Druk Gyalpo, under the theme “Leadership, Service, and Mindfulness Inspired by Bhutan’s Vision for Youth.” Bangladesh Scouts shall send a contingent to this event. Interested Scouts and Adult Leaders are invited to apply through the proper channel. Basic information of this event is mentioned below:

Name of the Event	: First National Scout Jamboree 2026
Date	: 26 – 30 May 2026
Venue	: National Scouts Centre, Paro, Bhutan
Eligibility	: Scouts: Minimum Progress Badge holder, Male and female Scouts aged 14–17 years at the time of the event (25 May 2026). Previous camping experience is mandatory. Adult Leaders: Minimum Wood-badger. Must be below 50 years of age (as of 25 May 2026) and be able to communicate in English. Previous experience as unit leader in a national camp or experience of an international event will be preferred. All participants must have a valid passport with at least 6 months validity beyond May 2026, Visa will be processed through organizers.
Expenditure	: Registration fee: USD 300 Token contribution per participant. This fee covers 6 nights’ accommodation in hotel/ camp/homestay, meals, excursion trips, inland airport transfer, souvenirs, activities. SDF Waived for Jamboree duration (25–31 May 2026), Additional costs to be borne by participants. An approximate amount of Taka =115,000 (One Lac & Fifteen Thousand) only may be required to attend the Event including Airfare, inland transportation in Bangladesh, food during traveling, and visa fee. The expenditure may vary due to increases in airfare and currency exchange rates. Participants themselves will have to bear all expenses related to the attendance of this event and Bangladesh Scouts will not have any financial involvement.
Event activities & special notes	: - Outdoor adventure, community service, cultural exchange, campfire, and dialogue on leadership & mindfulness. - International Night: Bring traditional snacks, sweets, souvenirs, cultural attire. Country quota: Maximum 10 members (8 Scouts – 4 male + 4 female, and 2 Adult Leaders – 1 male + 1 female). Tentative date of interview for selection: 26 April 2026.
