

In making its recommendations, the APR Awards Committee shall consider the following:

1. Consideration should be given to active leaders at the peak of their service to Scouting within the Asia-Pacific Region, in order to avoid a situation where the award is presented to the awardees at the end of her/his service to Scouting.
2. Some geographical spread of the award is desirable.
3. All decisions must be made in an open and transparent manner, considering all aspects of their service to the Asia-Pacific Region.

Recommendations should be received by the APR Awards Committee at least six (6) months before the presentation date of the award.

The award shall not be given to more than one person from a member country during one award year period. The current elected members of the Regional Committee, however, shall not be eligible to receive the award whilst serving as members of the APRSC.
