## Invitation for Applications to Participate in the Turkic World Jamboree 2026, Istanbul

The Scouting and Guiding Federation of Türkiye will host the Turkic World Jamboree 2026 (Turkic Scout Toy) from 15–25 July 2026 in Istanbul, Türkiye. Scouts from around the world will gather for a unique experience of learning, adventure, and cultural exchange. The Application forms are also attached herewith. Basic information of this event is mentioned below:

Name of the Event	: The Turkic World Jamboree 2026
Date	: 15–25 July 2026
Venue	: Beykoz Scouting Camp and Training Center, Istanbul, Türkiye
Eligibility	: <b>Scouts:</b> Minimum Standard Badge holder, Male and female Scouts aged 12 to 17 years old at the start of the Camp. Previous experience of camping will be preferred. <b>Adult Leaders:</b> Minimum Wood-badger, Previous experience as an unit leader in a national camp or experience of an international camp will be preferred. All participants must have a valid passport with at least 6 months' validity beyond July 2026, be eligible for Türkiye visa, be able to communicate in English, and be ready to perform any necessary tasks.
Expenditure	: Registration fee: Participation is free of charge. Breakfast, lunch, dinner, and an afternoon snack will be provided by camp organizer. Each participant will receive: A memory scarf, A special camp T-shirt & A camp badge. Participants must arrange their own transfer from airport/train station/bus terminal to the camp site. An approximate amount of Taka = 140,000 (One Lac- & Forty Thousand) only may be required to attend the Event including Airfare, inland transportation, food during traveling, and visa service fee. The expenditure may vary due to increases in airfare and currency exchange rates. Participants themselves will have to bear all expenses related to the attendance of this event and Bangladesh Scouts will not have any financial involvement.
Event activities & special notes	: The Turkic World Jamboree 2026 will be held in Istanbul, the unique location that combines Europe and Asia, thousands of years of historical texture, impressive landscapes and cultural richness, which offers an unforgettable scouting experience that brings together history, culture and adventure. An international scouting camp will offer nature-based training in orienteering, survival, and camping skills, along with team games, night hikes, and cultural campfire events. Scouts will celebrate global friendship on "International Day" and explore Istanbul's heritage on 2 days special sightseeing program. Countries and groups are welcome to share their skills by organizing training or activity stations. The Girls' and Boys' scout camps will be set up as separate sub-camps within the same camp facility. Scouts will stay with their own age groups. Participants must bring their own tent, sleeping bag, mat, and their country's flag (minimum 2 flags, size 1x1.5 meters). Country Quota: Maximum 20 participants (Scouts + Leaders) per country.



Submission of Application	: All interested applicants are requested to send the duly filled up application form (with photocopy of the necessary documents) through proper channel to the National Headquarters of Bangladesh Scouts within 21 April 2026. Bangladesh Scouts will not entertain any application after the deadline.
