Guidance Notes on the use of The Request for Quotation Document

1. These guidance notes have been prepared by the BPPA to assist a Procuring Entity in the preparation of Quotation document, using the Standard Request for Quotation, SRFQ, for the procurement of low value Goods. All concerned are advised to refer to the Public Procurement Rules, 2025 issued to supplement the Public Procurement Act, 2006; available on BPPA's website: <http://www.bppa.gov.bd/>. Notes and guidance are provided for both the Procuring Entity and the Quotationer.
2. The procurement under Request for Quotation Method (RFQM) shall follow the provisions pursuant to Rules 90 to 94 of the Public Procurement Rules, 2025 and in accordance with Section 32 of the Public Procurement Act, 2006. SRFQ is based upon best national practices that have been adapted to suit the particular needs of procurement.
3. The use of SRFQ (PG1) applies when a Procuring Entity intends to select a Quotationer (a Supplier) for the Procurement of Goods under RFQ Method (RFQM) pursuant to Rule 90(3) of the Public Procurement Rules, 2025.
4. Pursuant to Rule 92(1) and Rule 92(2) of the Public Procurement Rules, 2025, RFQ shall be invited through letter or e-mail. RFQ shall not be required to be advertised in the daily newspapers but for the minimum circulation the Procuring Entity shall publish that advertisement in its website (if any), including posting in the Notice Board and, shall send with request for publication to the administrative wing of some other Procuring Entities nearby.
5. Pursuant to Rule 92(3) of the Public Procurement Rules, 2025, RFQ Document shall be issued or made available to potential Quotationers 'free-of-cost'.
6. The time-limit for Request for Quotation shall in no case exceed seven (7) days pursuant to Rule 92 (4) of the Public Procurement Rules, 2025. The Procuring Entity must provide minimum three (3) days for submitting Quotations.
7. No Securities such as Quotation Security (i.e. Tender Security) and Performance Security shall be required pursuant to Rule 91(6) of the Public Procurement Rules, 2025.
8. Submission, Opening and Evaluation of the Quotations shall respectively be dealt with pursuant to Rule 93(1), Rule 93(2) and Rule 94(1) of the Public Procurement Rules, 2025 as specified in the RFQ.
9. The criteria for evaluation, pursuant to Rule 91(4) of the Public Procurement Rules, 2025, shall be pre-disclosed.
10. Pursuant to Rule 90(5) of the Public Procurement Rules, 2025 the Quotation for standard off-the-shelf low value readily available Goods shall usually be on 'Unit-Rate' basis.
11. The specifications of Goods shall be framed pursuant to Rule 38 of the Public Procurement Rules, 2025.
12. Splitting the object of Procurement is not permissible pursuant to Rule 90(4)(ka) of the Public Procurement Rules, 2025.
13. The Procuring Entity shall issue the Purchase Order, pursuant to Rule 94(5) of the Public Procurement Rules, 2025, to the successful Quotationer following recommendations of the Evaluation Committee and approval thereupon of the Approving Authority.
14. Provision of Retention Money shall however be kept at the rate of five (5) percent of the contract price from Supplier's payable amount against any claims during the Warranty Period.
15. The Warranty Period shall usually remain between 6 and 12 months.
16. The Procuring Entity shall further be required to maintain the record of procurement proceedings pursuant to Rule 60 of the Public Procurement Rules, 2025.

5. No Securities such as Quotation Security and Performance Security shall be required for submission of the Quotation and supply of the Goods (if awarded) respectively.
6. Quotation in sealed envelope or through electronic mail shall be submitted to the office of the undersigned on or before dated 04/05/2026 is 03:00 pm. The envelope containing the Quotation must be clearly marked "Quotation of Procurement for 8 (Eight) Video Tutorial of SMEF Training Program and DO NOT OPEN before 04/05/2026 is 03:00 pm. Quotations received later than the time specified herein shall not be accepted.
7. Quotations received through electronic mail shall be sealed-enveloped by the Procuring Entity duly marked as stated in Para 6 above and, all Quotations thus received shall be sent to the Evaluation Committee for evaluation, without opening, by the same date of closing the Quotation.
8. The Procuring Entity may extend the deadline for submission of Quotations on justifiably acceptable grounds duly recorded subject to threshold of seven (7) days pursuant to Rule 92 (4) of the Public Procurement Rules, 2025.
9. All Quotations must be valid for a period of at least [30 days] from the closing date of the Quotation.
10. No public opening of Quotations received by the closing date shall be held.
11. Quotationer's rates or prices shall be inclusive of profit and overhead and, all kinds of taxes, duties, fees, levies, and other charges to be paid under the Applicable Law, if the Contract is awarded.
12. Rates shall be quoted and, subsequent payments under this Contract shall be made in Taka currency. The price offered by the Quotationer, if accepted shall remain fixed for the duration of the Contract.



13. Quotationer shall have legal capacity to enter into Contract. Quotationer, in support of its qualification, shall be required to submit certified photocopies of latest documents related to valid Trade License, Clearance Certificate (or Acknowledgement slip issued by the competent authority as a proof of submission of income tax return for the Assessment Year-2023-24, VAT Registration Number/Business Identification Number (BIN) and Financial Solvency Certificate showing liquid asset of at least BDT (*please mention amount equalling seventy percent (30%) of the estimated cost*) from any scheduled Bank; without which the Quotation may be considered non-responsive.
14. Quotations shall be evaluated based on information and documents submitted with the Quotations, by the Evaluation Committee and, at least three (3) responsive Quotations will be required to determine the lowest evaluated responsive Quotations for award of the Contract.
15. In case of anomalies between unit rates or prices and the total amount quoted, in the quotation submitted on unit rate basis, the unit rates or prices shall prevail. In case of discrepancy between words and figures, the former will govern. Quotationer shall remain bound to accept the arithmetic corrections made by the Evaluation Committee.
16. The Quotationers prices, being responsive to the Procuring Entity's requirements, shall be checked for SLT (Significantly Low-priced Tender) in accordance with the Rules 25 and 26 of the Public Procurement Rules, 2025.
17. The supply of Goods shall be completed within [30] days from the date of issuing Purchase Order.
18. The Purchase Order that constitutes the Contract binding upon the Supplier and the Procuring Entity shall be issued within [01] days [*but not more than three (3) days*] of receipt of approval from the Approving Authority.
19. The Procuring Entity reserves the right to reject all the Quotations or annul the procurement proceedings.

1. Terms and Conditions contained herein shall be binding upon both the Procuring Entity and the Supplier for the purpose of administration and management of this Contract.
2. Implementation and interpretation of these Terms and Conditions shall, in general, be under the purview of the Public Procurement Act, 2006 and the Public Procurement Rules, 2025.
3. The Supplier shall have to complete the delivery in all respects within [insert days] days of issuing the Purchase Order in conformity with the Terms and Conditions.
4. The Supplier shall be entitled to an extension of the Delivery Schedule if the Procuring Entity delays in receiving the Goods or if Force Majeure situation occurs or for any other reasons acceptable to the Procuring Entity on justifiable grounds duly recorded.
5. All delivery under the Contract shall at all times be open to examination, inspection, measurements, testing, commissioning, and supervision of the Procuring Entity or the Technical Examination and Acceptance Committee (TEAC) formed by the PE.
6. The Procuring Entity shall check and verify the delivery made by the Supplier in conformity with the Technical Specifications and notify the Supplier of any Defects found.
7. If the Goods are found to be defective or otherwise not in accordance with the specifications, the Procuring Entity may reject the supplies by giving due notice to the Supplier, with reasons.
8. The Supplier shall be entirely responsible for payment of all taxes, duties, fees, and such other levies under the Applicable Law.
9. Notwithstanding any other practice, the payment shall be based on the actual delivery of goods on the basis of the quantity of each item of Goods in accordance with the Priced Schedule and Specifications. 100% of the Contract price of the Goods shall be paid after submission and acceptance of the Delivery Chalan.
10. The Supplier's rates or prices shall be inclusive of profit and overhead and, all kinds of taxes, duties, fees, levies, and other charges to be paid under the Applicable Law.

Terms of Reference (ToR)

Video Tutorial of SMEF Training Program

Introduction

Small and Medium Enterprise Foundation (SMEF), widely known as SME Foundation, is working as the national apex body for the promotion and development of SMEs in Bangladesh. As the principal implementing authority of the National SME Policy, SMEF plays a central role in promoting the growth and sustainability of micro, small, and medium enterprises (MSMEs) across the country. Its core activities are implementing SME policy strategies taken by Bangladesh Government, undertaking policy advocacy and interventions, facilitating financial access for SMEs, providing skill development and capacity-building trainings, supporting technology adaptation and ICT access, and delivering a wide range of business support services. SME Foundation is working for the development of enterprises and entrepreneurs who belong to micro, small and medium categories as per National Industrial Policy 2022. Special emphasis is placed on empowering women entrepreneurs. SMEF hosts numerous training programs to help SMEF entrepreneurs improve their skills and grow their capacity as part of this development process.

Description of Assignment

The "Video Tutorial Clippings (Tutorial AV) for Different types of Training Programs are planned, designed, organized, and implemented by the SME Foundation (SMEF). The SME Foundation plans to keep video recordings of the regular trainings it has organized for the fiscal year 2025–26. Everyone is eager to obtain online content these days due to the introduction of digital media. These Tutorial AV will be shared on social media sites including the SMEF website, SMEF Facebook page and SMEF YouTube channel in order to reach a wide audience of businesses. Even the most remote business owners may find the short videos on talent development useful. The purpose of these video courses is to assist entrepreneurs in developing their skills.

Assessment of the Bids

The bid evaluation procedure will be divided into two phases. In the first stage, "Costs and planning" will be looked at. After the second phase, which primarily entails inviting the qualified parties to a face-to-face encounter at a scheduled time, a final party will be selected. You will be informed if your quotation has been selected or not.

All pre-to-post-production duties, including concept development, research, shooting, online and offline editing, music, graphics, animation, dubbing, subtitles, and final mastering, will be completed by the selected company under its own supervision and with technical support.

There will be Thirteen (14) video tutorials in total, along with Beautification and Parlor Management (Hair Cut, Manicure and Pedicure, Rebonding, Bridal Makeup, Party Makeup, Facial), Culinary, Fast Food & Baking Items (Fast Food Preparation & Baking items) and Bloc Batik, Natural Drying, Screen Print. A variety of preparation and production processes will be covered in these educational videos.

1. All video tutorials must be sent to SMEF in 4K resolution, which is 4096 x 2160 pixels.
2. The video tutorials must be sent to SMEF in a format that can be used for offline and online promotion.
3. SMEF have the solely rights to make copies of the tutorial videos and to share the tutorials offline and online
4. The original raw footage should be delivered to SMEF and it should not be used anywhere further.
5. The music and video copyright is exclusive for SMEF and should be upheld by YouTube or any other social media guidelines.
6. The contractor will have to provide list of Technical Crews: (1. Director, 2. Cameraman/Cinematographer, 3. Editor, 4. Graphic Designer, 5. Music Director and 6. Voice-over artist/s (male and female).
7. The contractor shall take overall responsibilities on the quality and timeliness of the assignment.
8. In order to ensure that the assignment is completed correctly, SMEF employees will either provide the contractors with the necessary resources and information or assist them in contacting the relevant public authorities to obtain the necessary information.

Eligible criteria of the Firm/Vendor

- The organization must submitted Brochures/Company Profile (describing the company's expertise, strengths, list of experiences with client contact reference, core functions, products and services, list of professional staff/resources, and equipment available to carry out the assignment).
