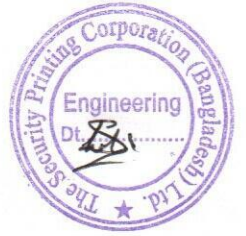



The authority reserves the right to reject or accept any or all Tenders without assigning any reason whatsoever. ## **A. SYNOPSIS OF TENDER.**

1. Scope of work : REMOVAL OF OLD DAMAGED LIME TERRACING AND RECONSTRUCTION OF NEW LIME TERRACING AT SPC SCHOOL OLD ACADEMIC BUILDING, SPCBL, GAZIPUR.
2. Price of Tender schedule : Tk.200.00 (Two Hundred Taka) only (Non-refundable).
3. Date of publish of Tender : 26/02/2026.
4. Last date and time for Submission of tender. : 30/03/2026 up to 11.00 AM
5. Date and time for opening of tender. : 30/03/2026 at 11.15 AM.
6. Earnest money : 3% (three percent) of the total quoted price.
7. Validity of Offer : 120 (One Hundred Twenty) days from the date of opening of the tender. May be extended if necessary.
8. Agreement : The sealed & signed copy of the work order (Saealed & signed by the successful bidder) will be Considered as the agreement between the bidder & the SPCBL.
9. Validity of earnest money : Validity of offer+28 days i.e. 148 days from the date of opening of tender.
10. Performance guarantee : 10% (ten percent) of the total quoted price must have to be provided by the successful bidder within 10 (ten) working days from the date of issue of work order in the form of pay order/DD/irrevocable Bank Guarantee. If the PG is not submitted in time the work order will be cancelled and earnest money will be forfeited.
11. Validity of performance guarantee : 28 (Twenty Eight) days from the date of complition of works. The validity of performance guaranty may be required to extend by the successful Bidder as and when desired by SPCBL without any question or dispute from the bidder's side before expiry of the guarantee.



12. Time of completion of work : The successful bidder shall have to complete the work within 60 (Sixty) days from the date of issuing of work order. Under some unavoidable circumstances if it is deemed reasonable the SPCBL authority may consider the extension of the work completion time (if necessary).
13. Payment of running bill : Contractor may submit part bill (not more than 01) for partial payment and after completion of total work they will submit final bill.
14. Period of warranty : The warranty period shall be 365 (three hundred sixty five) days after the date of acceptance of completed work by SPCBL.





## INSTRUCTION TO TENDERER/BIDDER.

1. (a) SPCBL means 'The Security Printing Corporation (Bangladesh) Ltd.  
(b) Earnest money means earnest money/security deposit/Tender security.
2. VALIDITY OF OFFER.  
The offer shall remain valid for acceptance upto 120 (One Hundred twenty) days from the date of opening of the tender. The validity of the offer may be extended by the bidder before the expiry if desired by the SPCBL.
3. QUOTATION OF PRICE:  
Prices should be firm for duration of the contract. No request for increase in price will be entertained. Prices shall be quoted in figures in the bid schedule. The price for the individual items of the Bid Schedule must have to be mentioned in figure & the total price must have to be mentioned both in figure & in words in the appropriate position of the Bid Schedule. The quoted total price shall determine the financial position of the offer/ tender. Overwriting offer, corrective fluid mark offer, fax/photocopy/erased offer in uploaded scanned documents / original documents may not be acceptable.
4. UPLOADED SCANNED DOCUMENTS:
  - a) Up-to-date Trade License,
  - b) e-TIN & VAT registration certificate.
  - c) Up-to-date Income tax certificate.
  - d) Work experience certificate: The bidders have to provide similar renovation/construction work experience certificate of worth Tk 5,00,000.00 (Five Lakh) or above. The Certificate should be signed by the Executive Engineer/Deputy Director or equivalent officer.
  - e) Bank solvency certificate: The bidder must submit a bank solvency certificate issued by any relevant Bank stating the position of the bank account of the bidder after published tender notice.

**Tenderer must be upload required commercial documents, Work experience certificate and Bank solvency certificate. Missing of any required documents (in case of not uploaded or any problem to download) will consider nonresponsive. No hard copy will be accepted.**
5. SIGNATURE OF TENDERER:
  - i) All uploaded scanned documents/original documents related with the offer must be with sealed & signed by the Tenderer and to be enclosed with the offer; otherwise the offer may be treated as cancelled. If the uploaded documents are signed by more than one person the responsibility will be several.
  - ii) The signature of the tenderer is to be of the chief executive or duly authorized representative. In case of authorized representative authorization letter in original must be sealed & signed by the chief executive.
6. POWER TO CANCELATION OF TENDER:  
The authority reserves the right to reject or accept any Tender without assigning any reason whatsoever.
7. AGREEMENT FOR WORKS :  
Each page of the issued work order must be sealed & signed by the successful bidder & submitted within 15 (ten) days after issuing of the same from SBCBL, failing of which in time the earnest money & the work order may be cancelled. The time may be extended to some extent by the SPCBL for the acceptable/reasonable ground.

8. TENDER ACCOMPANIMENTS.

- a) All documents, letters of instruction and modifications transmitted to the tenderer in connection with the preparation of the Tender shall have to be submitted as per the e-Tender Submission Agreement.
- b) Tenderer should provide all documentary evidence (original or attested whichever necessary) when requested failing of which the Tender may be considered as non-responsive.

9. CONDITION APPLY BY THE BIDDER:

Bidder should not apply any condition on the Tender Schedule; if so the offer will be treated as rejected.

10. SELECTION OF LOWEST BIDDER:

Total price of the responsive bidders sorted out after evaluation will be the basis for selection of the lowest bidder.

11. EARNEST MONEY.

A Pay order/Bank Draft/Bank Guarantee from any scheduled bank in Bangladesh for an amount of 3% (three percent) of the quoted price as earnest money in favor of The Managing Director, The Security Printing Corporation (Bangladesh) Ltd., Gazipur shall have to submit in the tender box kept at Corporations office in Gazipur. Tender without earnest money shall not be considered. The earnest money shall remain valid up to 148 days (validity of offer+28 days) from the date of opening of tender. In case of failure by a successful tenderer to enter into a contract for any reason, the SPCBL will forfeit the Pay order/Bank Draft. The Pay Order/Bank Draft of the successful tenderer will be returned after submission of performance guarantee (P.G) covering the proposed supply. The Pay Order/Bank Draft of other tenderer(s) except 1st and 2nd lowest tenderer will be returned after decision of the Tender Evaluation Committee and earnest money of 2nd lowest tenderer will be returned after the successful tenderer furnished a performance guarantee.

The earnest money of a tenderer shall be forfeited and the tenderer shall also be exempted from construction if the tenderer withdraws his offer within its validity or disagrees to amend the mistakes observed in the quoted price.

12. PERFORMANCE GUARANTEE.

The successful tenderer shall have to furnish a Performance Guarantee within 07 (Seven) days from the date of issue of NoA from any scheduled bank in Bangladesh on 300 (three hundred) Taka Non-Judicial Stamp at his own cost as per preforma at page 10 for an amount not less than 10% (ten percent) of the contract price. The performance guarantee shall remain valid up to 12 (twelve) months from the date of issue of performance guarantee or pay order/Bank draft. The validity of the guarantee may be required to extend as and when desired by the SPCBL, before the expiry of the guarantee at no cost of the SPCBL. If the successful bidder fails to execute any contractual obligations in time the said Performance Guarantee shall be forfeited. If the successful bidder fails to submit the Performance Guarantee the earnest money shall be forfeited.

13. LAW TO APPLY.

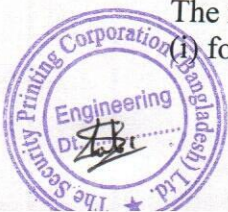
The contract shall be construed and operated and shall be interpreted in accordance with the Laws of Bangladesh.

14. LABOR SAFETY & SECURITY

The Contractor will provide proper safety and security for construction labor and their staff during construction period by their own cost.

The minimum cover for personal injury or death insurance:

(1) for the Contractor's employees is as per the law and common practice in Bangladesh.



(ii) and for third parties is as per the law and common practice in Bangladesh.

15. ATTESTED COPIES OF CERTIFICATES :

Photocopies of all certificates must be attested by Government/SPCBL/Bangladesh Bank's 1<sup>st</sup> class officer.

16. DATE AND TIME FOR SUBMISSION AND OPENING OF OFFER.

Deadline for submission of offer is up to 11.00AM on 30.03.2026. The offers will be opened at 11.15AM on the same day at SPCBL office in Gazipur in presence of the tenderer's representative, if any. The bidder shall have to submit the earnest money and price for procurement of tender schedule only in the tender box kept at Corporation office in Gazipur on or before the scheduled deadline.

17. PENALTY (LIQUIDATED DAMAGES) FOR DELAY IN THE CONSTRUCTION WORKS:

The amount of Liquidated Damages is 0.10 of ONE (1) percent of the contract value of the uncompleted works or any part thereof completed after expiry of the Intended Completion Date or extended Intended Completion Date, as applicable, per day of delay.

Liquidated damages is equivalent to an amount to be determined in accordance with the following formulae

$$T = V \times P \times n$$

Where;

T = Total amount of Liquidated Damages

V = Contract Value of Uncompleted Works, completed after the expiry of the Intended Completion Date or extended Intended Completion Date, as applicable

P = Percent-rate at which the Liquidated Damages shall be imposed per day of delay

n = No of days delayed for completion of uncompleted works or part thereof after the expiry of the Intended Completion Date or extended Intended Completion Date, as applicable.

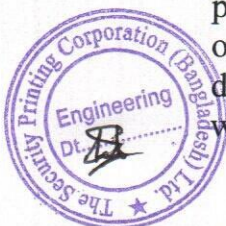
18. WARRANTY

There must have a warranty period of 12 months that is 365 (Three Hundred sixty five) days of the completed and accepted construction work. The warranty period will expire after 365(Three Hundred sixty five) days from the date of acceptance of the above said construction work by SPCBL. If there arise/found any defects/problems in any part of the constructed structure during the warranty period the contractor (successful bidder) must rectify the same at no cost of SPCBL immediately upon being notified by SPCBL without any arguments/debates from the contractors.

19. MODE OF PAYMENT

One partial bill and after completion of total work final bill may submitted for payment. The income tax, VAT etc. will be deducted from each bill as per the rules of corporation & Government. The 10% of the amount from final bill will be deducted as security money & will be kept with the SPCBL till the expiry of warranty period (12month after the acceptance of the whole work by SPCBL).

20. During the Weekly/Government holiday the construction work activity will be stopped but with the prior approval of the site Engineer the work may be continuous on the holidays also.





21. SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTE:

If any discrepancy/confusion arises regarding the terms & conditions stated above can be settled by mutual discussion between the SPCBL and tenderer(s).

22. Terms & conditions of the schedule must be strictly followed and construction shall have to make strictly following the technical specification of the tender schedule.

23. ARBITRATION.

In the event of any dispute arising under this contract the same shall be referred to a panel of arbitrators to be nominated one by the contractor and the other by the SPCBL within 15 (fifteen) days of notice from either side. In case the said arbitrators fail to agree to an award within one month, an umpire will be appointed by the two arbitrators in writing. The umpire shall give an award within one month. The decision of the arbitrators or the umpire as the case may be shall be final and binding on both the parties. The venue of arbitration will be Dhaka.
