Mr. Ahmed is a career diplomat. He joined the Bangladesh Foreign Service in 2006.

He joined the Embassy of Bangladesh in Thimphu as Minister in June 2025. Earlier, he served at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Government of Bangladesh as Director General, Director (Americas), Director (Foreign Minister's Office) and Director (SAARC). He also served in the Administration Wing, Multilateral Economic Affairs Wing and UNCLOS Wing of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs as Assistant/Senior Assistant Secretary.

Besides, he served as First Secretary at the Bangladesh Permanent Mission to the United Nations, New York from 2012 to 2015. Then he was posted to the Bangladesh High Commission to India in New Delhi where he served from 2015 to 2019 as Counsellor. He also served at the SAARC Secretariat from January 2021 to May 2025 as Director and, as an additional responsibility, he also acted as Officer-in-Charge of SAARC Development Fund from January 2024 to May 2025.

He studied at Institute of Business Administration (IBA), Dhaka University, Bangladesh.
