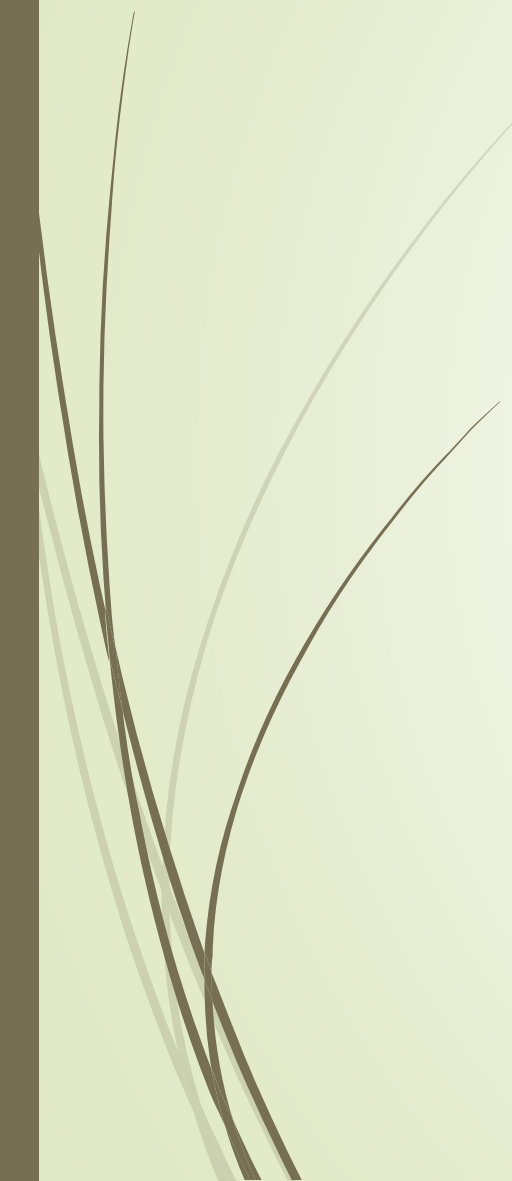

Transformation of sentences from affirmative to negative & vice-versa.

1. Only you are my best friend. (Negative)

None but you are my best friend.

2. Only the admit card is allowed in the exam hall.
(Negative)

Nothing but the admit card is allowed in the exam hall.

3. We must obey our parents. (Negative)

We cannot but obey our parents.



Assertive to Interrogative & vice-versa.

1. Every mother loves her child.

Which mother hates her child?

2. Everyone wants success in life.

Who doesn't want success in life?

3. She is a happy girl.

Isn't she a happy girl?

4. They have won the game.

Haven't they won the game?
